We reviewed the folder containing information relating to health and safety and building maintenance. We saw that the practice manager was monitoring and had copies of work carried out by the landlord including gas safety certificates, fire risk assessments and asbestos risk assessment. We also saw that the practice had procedures in place to ensure that they complied with any requirements identified in the risk assessments.
