Sacks Morasha Jewish Primary School	31 Stanhope road N12 9DX		A former Barnet College building on Stanhope Road - a Victorian church hall building - close to Tally Ho, was identified. With some ingenious configuration of space, including creating the school hall as a mezzanine space, and some sensitive discrete extensions to the historic fabric, a fully compliant 1-form entry school was created.

Colindale Campus Barnet and Southgate College	Bristol Ave. NW9 4BR	The Colindale campus gateway development comprises: Barnet and Southgate College, Inclusion Barnet and Colindale Library. The three zones operate harmoniously within 6,500m² of innovative learning and community space, easily accessible by tube and bus.
Belarussian Chapel	Marian House Holden Ave. N12 8HY	The first wooden church to be built in London since the Great Fire of 1666, the atmospheric qualities of the design not only emulate the wooded landscape of Belarus, but are also sympathetic to the 17 statutorily protected trees located on site. Entirely pre-fabricated, the light-weight timber structure is made sustainably sourced British Douglas fir, a nod to the historical connection of community and place.
Middlesex University Ritterman Building	12 Greyhound Hill, London NW4 4BT	The Ritterman building is Middlesex University's newest state-of-the-art teaching facility. It houses innovative facilities including robotics labs and mechatronics and provides students with the knowledge and skills they will need to succeed in their future careers and which mirror the needs of industry. The design was reached through extensive consultation with students and staff and it includes an in built flexibility to allow for future changes Materials used make the building appear as if it has been part of the landscape for many years.

Little lamps nursery	25 Cricklewood Ln, London NW2 1HP		The Little Lamps Nursery is a ground-breaking new learning through play centre based in an Edwardian church hall. Within this vast open space supported by magnificent riveted iron arches we have created an independent mezzanine insertion flanked by colourful stairs and an indoor climbing ramp and slide.
Salvation Army Hendon Corps	1-5 Brampton Grove NW4 4AE	THE SALWITH ARM	Completed in December 2016 our competition winning scheme demolished the existing, outdated facilities and provided a new worship hall and community centre for the Salvation Army Hendon Corps. Key design challenges included creating a single building which successfully accommodates the diverse mission of the Corps; providing a venue for worship, performance and for community activities such as the Barnet Dementia Hub, all under one roof.
Stonegrove Church and Community Centre	5 Hayling Way, Edgware HA8 8BN		The project is a unique collaboration between a number of church and community groups and their architects to create a building, which will serve the needs for both worship and wide range of community activities.

Colindale Gardens Peel square	Peel Centre NW9 5HU	THE STATE OF THE S	Peel Square is a key part of the considered landscape design for Redrow's Colindale Gardens' development, the new Colindale neighbourhood that will provide 2,900 new homes. The transformation of the former Metropolitan Police training campus into a new community includes Peel Square, a landscaped space that will breathe new life into the surrounding urban setting.
Oakleigh park school of swimming	On the grounds of Frith Manor School Lullington Garth Woodside Park N12 7BN		Located in the grounds of Frith Manor School this energy efficient and eco-friendly building blends well into the environment, with 83 solar panels and a unique energy saving water-pumping station. It caters for the modern and diverse needs of its users, which includes individuals, families and schools from the borough and surrounding area. With its Glulam beams and panoramic windows overlooking the countryside, it is a beautiful setting in which to swim and learn.
Apple Day Nursery	Kennard Mansions, Appledore House,, Friern Barnet Rd, N11 3DN		Externally, the Nursery has been designed to complement the surrounding existing buildings by incorporating some of the important features of neighbouring properties. One such feature is the roof design which consists of hipped pitched roofs. To bind the building and mark the entrance is a projecting bay.

Avenue House Estate	17 East End Road NW3 3QE	

The Avenue House Estate is a Grade II listed landscape containing five Grade II listed structures, two of which were on the Historic England 'At Risk' register. Works to the buildings within the landscape have included the re-purposing of the listed Stable Block and Garage as a café and activity and learning centre, the conservation of the listed and 'At Risk' Water Tower and Bothy Garden walls and the conversion of the toilet block into a café kiosk. The scheme has also provided a new depot building to support the future maintenance of the site. Through careful design and skilful execution, the Avenue House Estate has been preserved as a financially stable historic public space for future generations.
