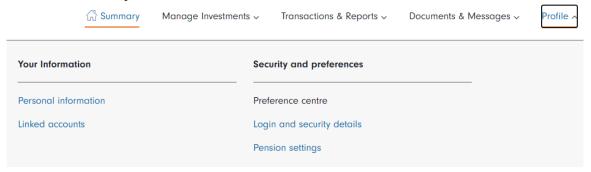


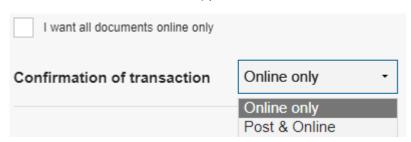
How to change your communication preferences online

If you want to change the way you receive documents and communications from Fidelity, you can use this guide to help you do it online.

- 1. Go to www.fidelity.co.uk
- **2.** Click on 'Log in' at the top right corner of the page before following the log in process. If you require help with the log in process, access our how to log in guide.
- **3.** The first screen you'll see is the Account Summary page. From the top menu of options on Account Summary, click on 'Profile'.

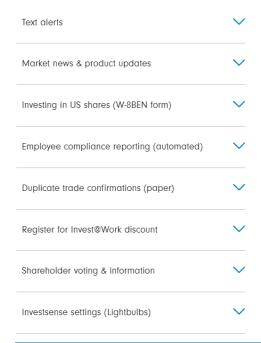


- 4. Then choose 'Preference centre' under the 'Security and preferences' heading.
- 5. This will open the 'Preference centre' panel on your screen.
- **6.** To change how you receive documents regarding your accounts, click on 'Account Documents' and select 'Change'
- 7. You can choose to receive all document online by selecting 'I want all documents online only', or you can select whether you would like to receive a document by 'Online only' or 'Post and Online' for each document type.

8. There are numerous communication and service preferences that you can amend under the 'Preference centre'. For each, toggle whether you opt in for the service, and how you would like to receive any relevant correspondence.
