KEEPING STUDENTS SAFE WITHIN OUR EVENTS

Voodoo Events are dedicated to making sure students receive the highest level of care, protection and safety possible when enjoying our events.

We work alongside venues, police, licensing and medical professionals to ensure they get the highest of care from arriving at our events to leaving.

This guide will give a brief insight into some of the processes we have throughout the course of an event.



ARRIVING AT OUR EVENTS



In venues such as Pryzm and the O2, all customers arriving at the venue will be searched, whether through wands, pat downs or even metal detector arches



Every customer has their ID checked and in all of our events. At Space, customers have their ID scanned into a database, so we have a log of all customers in attendance.



Customers are not permitted to enter the venue ALONE, as it's always safer for customers to be with a friend.

DURING OUR EVENTS



We have private medical staff and a medical room at many of our events, and medically trained staff at ALL events.



Customers who have had too much to drink are observed by our medical staff until they are ready to be put in a taxi.



Anti Spike measures are available in every event. Ask behind the bar for details



Hearing protection is available in every event.



Ask for Angela campaign is supported in all of our events. Along with "No Regrets" Leeds.

LEAVING OUR EVENTS



If students do not have a way to pay for the journey home, Voodoo will pay for it.



Staff are on hand to walk students to their taxi should they need assistance.



We make sure that if a student is too drunk, a friend escorts them home (and they will be permitted free entry and queue jump should they return once their friend is home safely).
