ASSEMBLY

6.5" WIDE TIRES


Install both tires using the supplied 1/2" bolts. Set Torque Wrench to 40 ft-lbf or ensure bolts are very tight. Recommended Tire Pressure: 90 PSI.

HANDLE & TIGHTENING BAR

Insert the Handle and secure with D-Clip. Install the Spring Clips onto the Handle to store the Tightening Bar.

WIRELESS CONTROLLER

Attach to the Handle using the provided D-Clip, or use wirelessly!





MODULE FEATURES



1 CIRCUIT BREAKERS

0

Prevents both Motors and Smart Brake from overheating. If a breaker trips, the Reset Button will extend up to 1/2" from the panel.

Allow 30 seconds for the system to cool down, then press Reset.

3 VOLT METER

Digital Meter that measures and displays Power Level of Battery. Fully Charged Batteries Rest between 12.6 to 13V.

2 POWER ON/OFF

Press and Hold for 2 seconds to turn ON or OFF.

4 SMART BRAKE

7-Way Power Plug that Controls the Trailer's Brakes.

Electric Brakes (RV Trailers): Engages brakes when the Dolly is powered ON and not in motion. Releases when the directional


toggle switch is pushed.

Surge Brakes (Boat Trailers): Releases the brakes as soon as the plug is connected to the Dolly.

WIRELESS CONTROLLER

SET UP

Remove the 4 cover screws. Plug the Battery and Charger cables into the circuit board to activate.



Battery Cable:

White Connector, 2 wires. There is a notch on the top to ensure proper polarity. Align this with the Notch label written on the circuit board.

Charger Cable:

Black Connector, 5 wires. Align the Red wire with the Red label written on the circuit board. Controller light will illuminate.





Replace the cover and charge overnight before first use. Compatible with any standard USB Phone Charger.


Due to Shipping Regulations, the lithium battery is only charged up to 30% capacity.






CONTROLLER OPERATION

All directional terms are from the user's point of view from behind the dolly, facing the trailer.





LEFT WHEEL

RIGHT WHEEL

The Transformer wheels are controlled independently by two, three-position rocker switches. Both switches may be operated individually, or at the same time. The middle position is off, or neutral.

SLEEP MODE

The wireless system will go to sleep after 30 seconds of inactivity, or when the Dolly is powered OFF.

To save battery life, it will wake up again when one of the Rocker Switches is pushed.

WIRELESS SYNC LIGHT

Steady Light: Wireless Connection Successful. Slow Blink: • • • Receiver is OFF or is out of range. Turn Dolly ON or walk closer to it. Fast Blink: • • • • • Controller Battery Low. Recharge.

DRIVE MODES:

FREEWHEEL

NEUTRAL. MOVE THE DOLLY <u>WITHOUT</u> POWER WHILE IT IS NOT UNDER LOAD.

If you are in Engaged Mode, the wheels will be locked in the drive position. Without power, the Dolly will only move an inch forwards or backwards before stopping.

Rock the Dolly so the wheels rest in between these two stop points. Pull on the Knob and turn it clockwise. Rest the small pin on the outer edge, not in the pin hole.

Repeat this on the other side of the Dolly.


ENGAGED

DRIVE. FOR CONNECTING TO THE TRAILER AND PARKING <u>WITH</u> POWER.

Ensure the Dolly is in parking position and ready to connect to the trailer hitch.


Pull on the Knob and turn it clockwise. Align the small pin with the corresponding slot. Rock the Dolly back and forth. The knob will pop in with a "click", engaging the Dolly into Drive.

Repeat this on the other side of the Dolly.

BALL MOUNT: SPACER PLATE

WHAT IS IT FOR?

The Spacer Plate is **only used with the Ball Mount Connection**. It locks the Receiver Tube in place to prevent Ball Mount movement while the dolly is in motion.

COMES PRE-INSTALLED IN BALL MOUNT ONLY TRANSFORMER PACKAGE.

INSTALLATION

Remove the Screws on the **Chain Cover** to access the **Receiver Tube**.

Remove the **Bolt** found at the base of the Receiver Tube Brackets.

Lay the **Spacer Plate** between the **Receiver Tube Brackets** with the notches facing down.

Place the Receiver Tube on top of the Spacer Plate, then re-install the bolt and Chain Cover.

REMOVE THE CHAIN COVER.



CONNECTING TO YOUR TRAILER: BALL MOUNT ADAPTER

With both motors in **Freewheel Mode**, move the Dolly and all required Accessories to the Trailer: **Ball Mount**, **Hitch Ball**, and **Torsion Loop**.




Insure spacer plate is installed before operating!

BALL MOUNT ASSEMBLY

HITCH BALL

Thread desired **Hitch Ball** into the Ball Mount. Apply a generous portion of **All-Purpose Grease** along the top surface of the **Ball Mount Collar**.

The shoulder of the Hitch Ball should rest slightly below the top of the collar.




HITCH BALL PLACEMENT

WELD SPOTS

Insert the assembled Ball Mount into the Hitch and lock as normal.

Make sure the **Weld Spots** on the Hitch Ball are pointed towards the **rear left side of your trailer at about 10 o'clock.**

The hitch may not lock if they are not positioned properly!



HITCH CONNECTION

Turn the Ball Mount **Counter Clockwise** until the gap between the Ball Mount Collar and Trailer Tongue closes **tightly**, with **no gap**.



Have a **Step Down Hitch** or another obstruction preventing a flat connection? SEE THRUST WASHER INSTALLATION.

THRUST WASHER

Place the Thrust Washer on top of the Ball Mount with the open section facing the trailer. While tightening, hold the Thrust Washer in place to prevent it from spinning.

Need to increase Ball Mount Height? Interlock the Puzzle Piece.

STILL HAVING TROUBLE? SEE ALTERNATE CONNECTIONS (PAGE 25)

TIGHTEN THE **BALL MOUNT**


TIGHTENING BAR

Once the Ball Mount is secure, use the Tightening Bar to ensure the connection is as tight as possible!

This will take a few rotations.

▲ DANGER


ENGAGE MOTORS INTO DRIVE


TURN ON THE DOLLY

Press and Hold the Power Button to turn on the Dolly. Connect the Trailer's 7 Pin Brake Cable to the Smart Brake Plug.

FREEWHEEL KNOBS

Ensure the Dolly is in parking position and ready to connect to the Hitch, then **Engage both Motors**. (See page 8)





BALL MOUNT STABILIZER

The **Torsion Loop** must only be used with the **Ball Mount Adapter**. This safety strap connector fits over the Transformer's Receiver Tube to reinforce the connection and prevent Dolly kick back while parking.

INSTALLATION

Slide the **Torsion Loop** onto the Dolly's **Receiver Tube**.

Point the small loop towards the center of your trailer.

ALIGN THE DOLLY

Using the **Handle Toggle Switches**, Drive the Dolly underneath the hitch. Align the **Adapter** with the top of the Dolly's **Receiver Tube**.






INSERT ADAPTER

Ensure that the **Trailer is Level and the Dolly is in the Drive Position.** Use the **Trailer Jack Stand** to fully lower the Ball Mount into the **Receiver Tube**.



RE-TIGHTEN BALL MOUNT

Using the **Toggle Switch**, move the Dolly back & forth slightly. **Re-tighten Ball Mount. Repeat 2-3 times** until you can't tighten anymore.



SECURE CONNECTION

RATCHET STRAPS

Once the Ball Mount is tightened, hook the **Ratchet Strap** to the **Torsion Loop**.

Attach the opposite end to a secure point around the **center** of the Trailer, then tighten the straps to secure.

The strap should not interfere with the Dolly's tires.



ENSURE BALL MOUNT IS AS TIGHT AS POSSIBLE BEFORE OPERATING!

CONNECTING TO YOUR TRAILER: FIFTH WHEEL ADAPTER

With both motors in **Freewheel Mode**, move the Dolly, Accessories and required Tools to the Trailer: **Kingpin Adapter, Stabilizer Bars** (Kingpin or Landing Leg), **Hardware, Socket Wrench and Drill with 13/32" drill bit**.


REMOVE BALL MOUNT SPACER PLATE BEFORE OPERATING! (SEE PAGE 9)

KINGPIN ADAPTER

INSTALLATION

Attach the Kingpin Adapter to the trailers' Kingpin and slide the U-shaped locking pin into place.

Secure this connection with the supplied D-Pin.




KINGPIN ADAPTER SET-UP

MEASUREMENTS

Kingpin measurements should be between **48"-52"** from the **Ground to the Bottom of the Kingpin Box**. If your measurements are not within this range, contact us before operating this machine!

The Adapter must be straight, and the trailer level. No part of the Adapter should be touching the ground when hooked up.



STABILIZER BAR INSTALLATION

The standard Transformer Fifth Wheel Package comes with Kingpin Stabilizer Bars. Landing Leg Stabilizers are available upon request.

KINGPIN BOX STABILIZERS

MOUNTING RING TUBE

With the wings of the **Mounting Ring Tube** parallel with the front of the trailer, slide it onto the Kingpin Adapter. The bottom edge must be flush with the base of the adapter. Tighten the set screws and secure with the 5" throughbolt and nut.

PIVOT TUBES

Install both **1 1/2" Pivot Tubes** to the wings of the Mounting Ring Tube with the 2 1/2" Bolts and lock washer.Turn the Pivot Tubes towards your trailer at a **45° angle** in preparation for the Inner and Outer tubes.

BOLTS & HARDWARE

With the 1 ½ inch bolt, flat washer and lock washer, thread the **Coupling Nut** into the outer portion of the **Kingpin Box**.


You may have to remove one of the existing bolts from your Kingpin Box.

Tighten the Coupling Nut as much as possible for a secure connection.

TRAILER MOUNT TUBES

Attach the **Trailer Mount Tube** to the **Coupling Nut**. Angle this in the direction of the **Pivot Tubes**.

Repeat these steps on the other side of the Kingpin Box.



INNER & OUTER TUBES

Slide the **Inner Tubes** into the **Pivot Tubes** at the base of the Kingpin Adapter.

Slide the **Outer Tubes** into the **Trailer Mount Tubes** on the Kingpin Box and secure them with the 4 supplied D-Pins.

DRILL PILOT HOLES


Using the pre-made holes in the Outer Tube as a guide, **drill a hole** into one side of the Inner Tube, and then the other to complete the through hole. **Secure these with D-Pins**.


We recommend a 13/32" drill bit.


TIGHTEN BOLTS

Tighten the 4 Bolts on the top and bottom pivot tubes to complete the setup.



LANDING LEG STABILIZERS

MOUNTING RING TUBES

Install both **Mounting Ring Tubes**. Secure the **Support Ring** onto the base of the adapter with the supplied set screws.

STABILIZER BARS

Install the Landing Leg Stabilizer Bars into the adapter's Ring Tubes, ensuring that the ends will attach to the Outside of the Trailer Legs. Secure these with the supplied D Clips.

BOLTS & WING NUTS

Point the **Stabilizer Bars** towards the trailer. Lock them to the **Trailer's Landing Legs** with the supplied **Bolts** and **Wing Nuts**.

Raise the Trailer Jack.




WHEN CONNECTING TO THE TRANSFORMER:

Once the trailer is close to level:

Drill a hole into one side of the **Inner Tube**, and then the other to complete the **hrough hole**. Repeat with the other Stabilizer Bar, then secure with **D-Pins**.

These holes only need to be drilled on the first installation.





ENGAGE MOTORS INTO DRIVE


TURN ON THE DOLLY


Press and Hold the **Power Button** to turn on the Dolly. Light will turn on.


Optional: Connect the Trailer's 7 Pin Brake Cable to the **Smart Brake Plug**.

FREEWHEEL KNOBS

Ensure the Dolly is in parking position and ready to connect to the Hitch, then **Engage both Motors**.







INSERT ADAPTER

Ensure that the **Trailer is Level**, **the Adapter is straight**, and the **Dolly is in the Drive Position**.

Re-adjust the Dolly with the **Wireless Controller** if needed.

Use the **Trailer Jack Stand** to fully lower the Adapter into the **Receiver Tube**.



PARKING YOUR TRAILER

DEMIG

Use the **Forward** and **Reverse** Toggle Switches to steer into tight spaces that are nearly impossible for vehicles.

The **Wireless Controller** can be used while attached to the Dolly, or from a distance for more precise parking.

DISCONNECTING THE HITCH

Chock Trailer Wheels to prevent a runaway trailer. **Raise the Trailer** to withdraw the **Adapter**.

The Adapter can be removed or left on the hitch for later use.

STORAGE & MAINTENANCE

Freewheel the Dolly to desired storage area, preferably under cover.

Charging the On-Board Battery: Plug the Battery Cable into the Dolly. Unplug the Handle Cable, then plug the Dolly's Charger Cable into a wall outlet. Stops charging automatically when full.

Grease the Receiver Tube and **Lubricate the Chain** with **Chain Lube**. Can be done annually, or more often if used more frequently.

TRAILER JACK POST


Remove the Ball Mount Adapter. Lower the Trailer Jack into the Dolly's **Receiver Tube**, following the standard connection process.


The trailer should rest as close to the Dolly's Tires as possible to reduce strain on the Jack Shaft.

TELESCOPIC FRAME ADAPTER

Remove the Ball Mount Adapter. Attach the Telescopic Adapter to the Y section of the trailer frame.

Lower the Telescoping Pipe into the Dolly, following the standard connection process. Slide the Adapter's locking pin into place.

2 YEAR PARTS & REPAIR WARRANTY

Your Parkit360 Dolly is covered for 2 years from the initial date of purchase. If a defect is found during this time, contact us with the original sales receipt number and details of the fault encountered.

Our Technical Support will attempt to solve the issue remotely. If the issue appears to be caused by defective parts, we will provide free replacement parts, excluding shipping costs.

If the 2 Year Warranty has expired or if you are not the original owner, you will have to pay the cost of parts and shipping. This repair will be covered for 3 months, starting 7 days from the date of shipment.

The Repair Warranty will expire either at the end of the 3 month period, or at the expiration of the original 2 -Year Warranty, whichever is later.

30 DAY RETURN POLICY

If a material defect is found or if the Parkit360 has failed to perform to your expectations, return it within 30 days of the date of sale for a refund, less the flat shipping cost of \$500 USD and 20% restocking fee.

- Pack the Dolly back into the box and onto the skid that it came in. Call us at 1-888-926-5517 EXT.1 to let us know about your return. Please provide us with your Sales Receipt or Online Order number.
- 2. Our staff will provide you with an RMA# that must be written on the box prior to sending. We will email you a Return Shipping Label that must be affixed to the box prior to drop off at your nearest FedEx Depot. *(If you are unable to drop off the Unit, Pick-Up can be arranged.)*
- 3. Receive your refund minus the shipping and restocking fee once the Dolly arrives at our warehouse.

EXCLUSIONS AND LIMITATIONS

The 2 Year Warranty and 30 Day Return Policy do not cover:

- Normal wear and tear of the Parkit360 from use
- Shipping Costs for Returns / Repairs
- Customer Neglect and Improper Use or Storage of the Parkit360
- · Modified Dollies, or if the Serial Number has been altered or removed
