Who we are and how we use your personal information

We take our commitment to maintaining the privacy and security of your personal data extremely seriously, ensuring that we meet all data protection requirements. We do not pass on any of the information that you give us to any third parties, except in circumstances where such information may be requested by the police to ensure the security of our events.

What we collect and why

The CCFA and ACFA will only collect the personal data that is absolutely necessary in order for us to communicate with our work related contacts and for the purpose of achieving the objectives of the CCFA and ACFA.

We do not process any personal data nor pass on this information to any third parties or for profiling purposes.

We will not continue to hold any of your data any longer than is required and we will review all data held annually.

How will the information be stored

Information will be stored on our business IT system through our IT partners. Management and storage of data conforms to ISO/IEC 27001, certificate number IS 670085.
