

Guidelines for dealing with an Incident / Accident

1. Head southwest on Burley Rd toward Wedgewood Gardens About 6 mins	go 2.6 mi total 2.6 mi
↶ 2. Turn left onto Salisbury Rd/B3347 Continue to follow B3347 About 4 mins	go 1.7 mi total 4.3 mi
➤ 3. Keep right at the fork	go 272 ft total 4.3 mi
↶ 4. At the roundabout, take the 4th exit onto Christchurch By Pass/A35 Continue to follow A35 Go through 3 roundabouts About 6 mins	go 2.2 mi total 6.5 mi
↶ 5. At the roundabout, take the 3rd exit onto Castle Ln E/A3060 About 2 mins	go 0.7 mi total 7.2 mi
➤ 6. Turn right onto Deansleigh Rd Go through 2 roundabouts About 2 mins	go 0.2 mi total 7.4 mi
↶ 7. Turn left	go 472 ft total 7.5 mi
↶ 8. Turn left	go 184 ft total 7.5 mi

- Stay calm but act swiftly and observe the situation.
- Is there a risk of further injury?
- Listen to what the injured person is saying.
- Alert the qualified First Aider who should take appropriate action for minor injuries.
- In the event of an injury requiring specialist treatment, call the emergency services – **999**.

- Deal with the rest of the group and ensure that they are adequately supervised and safe.
- Do not move someone with major injuries. Wait for the emergency medics.
- Contact the injured person's parent / carer / guardian.
- Complete an Incident / Accident Report Form.
