Multiple Pitch Layouts

Where multiple pitches are to be laid out in close proximity there is a requirement for a space of 3 metres between the outside lines of the run-off areas. This is for both safety and to accommodate spectators.

There is no requirement for additional space between in-goal areas other than to accommodate spectators and it is therefore discretionary.

Figure 1 Example Layout








Figure 2 Full Size PREFERRED Pitch Dimensions






Figure 4 Under 9, Under 10 and Under 11 (11-a-side) Pitch Dimensions




Figure 6 Under 7 & Under 8 MINIMUM Pitch Dimensions




Figure 8 Touch Rugby League PREFERRED Pitch Dimensions

Post height 4 to 5 m, post width apart: 3m, crossbar height above floor: 2m.

Surface must be hard, level and consistent to ensure good, safe running for wheelchairs.

The centre, 4 and 8 metre lines must be clearly marked using (1) adhesive tape (on floor), (2) paint (on concrete) or (3) plastic cones or domes (placed 1m outside touch lines).
