Action to be considered	Action taken
Hand Washing facilities with soap and water in place	All players encouraged to wash hands before arrival and on return home.
Gel sanitizer readily available and used regularly	Each bubble to have a bottle of sanitizer – to be used on arrival, during the session and at the end before departure.
Disposable towels available and used to wipe sweat off face	Age group players don't have excessive amounts of sweat. Players encouraged to bring own towel if they feel they need it.
Equipment cleaned before use	 Each bubble coach to have a separate set of equipment for sole use of their bubble – to include: Balls Cones Hand sanitizer Balls and cones to be cleaned before and after training – or left untouched between sessions of more than 72 hours apart.
Minimise sharing of equipment	Equipment (balls and cones) only to be used by individual bubble – and cleaned after use.
No sharing of water bottles	All players told to bring own water bottle and each coach to remind players, no sharing
No close physical contact	Training programmes to avoid contact and players to be reminded by Coach on arrival

No hand shaking	All players and coaches to be reminded prior to training
First aid provision	First aider to be on site during training First aider to have personal PPE – mask and gloves.
Note to parents/players – advising of approach	Note (attached) prepared and issued to parents ahead of training
Managing numbers	All parents to confirm attendance at training 24 hours ahead of training – so that bubbles can be set Players to be informed of bubble ahead of training to avoid discussion/confusion at training.
