Action to be considered	Action taken
<b>Hand Washing facilities with soap and water in place</b>	All players encouraged to wash hands before arrival and on return home.
<b>Gel sanitizer readily available and used regularly</b>	Each bubble to have a bottle of sanitizer – to be used on arrival, during the session and at the end before departure.
<b>Disposable towels available and used to wipe sweat off face</b>	Age group players don't have excessive amounts of sweat. Players encouraged to bring own towel if they feel they need it.
<b>Equipment cleaned before use</b>	Each bubble coach to have a separate set of equipment for sole use of their bubble – to include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Balls</li> <li>• Cones</li> <li>• Hand sanitizer</li> </ul> Balls and cones to be cleaned before and after training – or left untouched between sessions of more than 72 hours apart.
<b>Minimise sharing of equipment</b>	Equipment (balls and cones) only to be used by individual bubble – and cleaned after use.
<b>No sharing of water bottles</b>	All players told to bring own water bottle and each coach to remind players, no sharing
<b>No close physical contact</b>	Training programmes to avoid contact and players to be reminded by Coach on arrival

<b>No hand shaking</b>	All players and coaches to be reminded prior to training
<b>First aid provision</b>	First aider to be on site during training First aider to have personal PPE – mask and gloves.
<b>Note to parents/players – advising of approach</b>	Note (attached) prepared and issued to parents ahead of training
<b>Managing numbers</b>	All parents to confirm attendance at training 24 hours ahead of training – so that bubbles can be set Players to be informed of bubble ahead of training to avoid discussion/confusion at training.
