career in sport working for Umbro UK and Irwin Mitchell's relationship with the RFU.

The first time she refereed a match was in Vancouver, Canada. She was asked by her club, Capilano RFC, to referee an U14 boys 7s tournament – one week after doing her referee certification.



Rugby Canada wanted to increase the number of female officials across the country, so all clubs with a women's team were told they needed a female referee associated to the club. Her coach selected her as a suitable candidate. Following a car accident she couldn't play rugby any more, and found that she preferred refereeing to coaching. She was an Assistant Referee to Joy Neville for the England Women v Scotland Women Six Nations match in 2018 at Twickenham. She has also refereed a Women's Varsity Match in 2021.
