# CLUB HISTORY

Woodley United FC was formed in 2011 as a result of four Woodley based football clubs and Berks & Bucks FA recognising that the provision of women's and girls' football in the town would be better provided by one club dedicated to this purpose rather than the existing clubs each having one female team to satisfy FA Charter Standard needs but no player progression policy.



During its time as a female club, Woodley United FC saw success on and off the pitch. This included coaching in schools, supporting the Woodley Community Carnival inter school tournaments, being presented the Wokingham Borough Sports Council annual award for Service to Sport in and the Community in 2014, winning four Berks & Bucks FA County cups and the Southern Region Women's Football League league cup.

Such were the benefits of working together that two of the town's oldest clubs, Woodley Town FC and Woodley Hammers FC in conjunction with Woodley United FC saw greater opportunities for the provision of local football if the clubs were to amalgamate. As such a "One Woodley" steering group was created in April 2014 and has overseen proceedings so that from 2015 – 16 the three clubs have been playing under the Woodley United FC name.

The objective of the club is to "offer everyone in our community the opportunity to play, develop and grow through football, regardless of race, gender, age or ability" and in so doing provide community based football that is the envy of the footballing world." To help with this objective the club is a FA Charter Standard Community Club.

The FA's National Clubs' Manager Mick Backie stated "The vision, ambition and purpose of the One Woodley project is an inspirational football model that places the players and its community at its core."

The club provides football from mini-kickers (pre-school), youth through to adult (male & female) and veterans and has gone on to further be presented the Wokingham Borough Sports Council annual award for Service to Sport in and the Community in 2015, 2017 and 2019. The club also has players of Reading FC Women's team, coach and manager the men's Saturday Step 7 Reserve side.

This season sees the men's 1<sup>st</sup> team play in UHlsport Hellenic League Division One East, the ladies team competing in the Premier Division of the Southern Region Women's Football League (Tier 5 of FA Women's football pyramid) and the Veterans playing in the Hellenic Veterans Premier Division following their Division One league title and league cup success last year.

Appointed Manager of the team in November 2019. Previously managed the club's Reserve side and worked with a number of our youth teams.

## Holyport FC • Club History

Holyport Football Club was formed on 1st September 1897 in The George Pub in Holyport Village, with 20 members at a Shilling a piece to join. Initially they played in the Maidenhead and District League, their home ground was at Windsor Road, Bray. The club slowly progressed and joined the Hayes and Giles League where they played their home games at Braywick Park.



At the beginning of the 2002/2003, after three very successful seasons, Holyport were promoted to the Hellenic League Division 1 East. Two seasons later they moved to their current ground at Summerleaze Village in North Maidenhead. This move signaled the start of a new and exciting era for the club. Having secured the necessary planning permission, as well as funding from the Football Foundation, the new ground has been in a state continuous of improvement. In season 2007/8 the ground was fenced, floodlights installed and since then has seen further improvements to the changing facilities, hard standing on three sides of the ground, the erection of three spectator grandstands and a hospitality room. These changes are the culmination of several years of hard work and the club's Summerleaze Village ground now meets the F.A and League requirements for Holyport to continue to play at their current step five level of football.

These continuous improvements, both of and off the pitch, have all contributed to progressing the Club's ambitions of playing in the F.A. Carling Vase and the FA Cup which they achieved in 2008 and 2010 respectively. Additionally in 2009/10 season and 2010/11 season the club was jointly awarded the Hungerford Cup (shared with Shortwood United in 2009/10 and then Thame United 2010/11). The cup is awarded to the club who has shown the most development, both on and off the field, throughout the season. The award in particular, recognizes the tremendous amount of hard work that Club Secretary, Graham Broom has put in season after season along with a dedicated committee.

2010/11 Season was a historic season for Holyport. In their first season with the club the new management team of Derek Sweetman, Kevin Carvell and Calvin Maye led the side to the Uxbridge Hellenic 1 Division East title, AM Print and Copy Floodlit Cup and The Bluefin Insurance Challenge Cup. In 2009/10 Jamie Handscomb was also recognised by the League winning the Divisional Player of the Year award, the third time a Port player has won this trophy. Along with the Hungerford Cup, four cups in one season will probably be the club's most successful season for a good number of years to come. The 2011/12 Season saw Holyport finish a very respectable 13th in their debut season and also as Semi Finalists in The Berks and Bucks Senior Cup and League Supplementary Cup. The 2012/13 brought yet more development for Holyport FC as they fielded their first ever Youth side in The Allied Counties League. 2014/15 saw Martin Kenealy step aside after 12 months in charge, The committee had a think about the future and decided to was best to step down to Division One East and promote Barry, Dan, Chris and John into the management setup. The side had a steady season in 2015/16 but 2016/17 was a struggle. 2017/18 saw Dan and Chris move on but ex Holyport player Matt Rolfe was appointed as Asst Manager and with this the team finished 5th in the league. Barry Rake resigned in the summer of 2018 and with this the club appointed Derek Sweetman as Manager for 2018/19 season with Rolfe, Ovens and Deverall assisting him. Along with this the side re-entered the FA Cup and announced a three year sponsorship deal with Anthony Mullan furniture. The 18/19 season produced a good FA Vase run and once again a 5th place in the league but securing more points than the previous season.

Ullsport Hellenic League – Division One East – 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2020

On a sticky pitch with wind once again blowing from touchline to touchline, United twice came from behind for a deserved share of the points with captain Luke Axton-Hall atoning for his own goal in the last home game, scoring his first goal for the club that levelled the scores at two apiece.

The home team started the better but fell behind in the tenth minute when left back Lewis Thorne beat Craig McCreeth from the edge of the penalty area firing into the keeper's left hand corner. United wobbled for a period and it needed a block by Jamaal Whight in the goal area to prevent Thame doubling their score six minutes later.

The nineteen minute saw Woodley have a strong appeal for a penalty turned down when Max Laschok was bundled off the ball but the forward got his reward when his cross from the goal line was met by Lamin Ceesay to level from close range in the twenty first minute. A slip by Axton-Hall on the testing surface allowed Joe Walls to shoot and hit the net station from the kick off but after this the best chances were created by Woodley with Ceesay dangerous when running the defence and linking well with Laschok.

Calvin Evans fired a shot over the home cross bar from range seven minutes before the break that saw both teams go in level one apiece.

Despite Woodley starting the second half in positive manner McCreeth was called on to make a good save from Walls for a corner in the fifty fifth minute from which Rangers kept the pressure on the home defence and where rewarded a minute before the hour mark when a good run and pass from midfield found Ben Lloyd to restore their lead.

United rallied and Laschok rounded visiting keeper Archie Davies only for his goal bound shot to be cleared off the goal line. This was followed in the seventy first minute of Axton-Hall heading substitute Josh Millo's corner onto the upright with Harry Hawkins firing the rebound goal wards that was cleared off the line to Millo whose low cross found Axton-Hall to have his shot cleared off the line. Buoyed by this pressure United forced another corner in the seventy sixth minute which this time saw Axton-Hall's header hit the back of the net from Millo's kick.

With legs tiring on the heavy pitch chances then became fewer as the teams played out the remaining time and the match ended all square.
