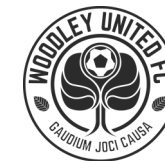

CLUB HISTORY

Woodley United FC was formed in 2011 as a result of four Woodley based football clubs and Berks & Bucks FA recognising that the provision of women's and girls' football in the town would be better provided by one club dedicated to this purpose rather than the existing clubs each having one female team to satisfy FA Charter Standard needs but no player progression policy.



During its time as a female club, Woodley United FC saw success on and off the pitch. This included coaching in schools, supporting the Woodley Community Carnival inter school tournaments, being presented the Wokingham Borough Sports Council annual award for Service to Sport in and the Community in 2014, winning four Berks & Bucks FA County cups and the Southern Region Women's Football League league cup.

Such were the benefits of working together that two of the town's oldest clubs, Woodley Town FC and Woodley Hammers FC in conjunction with Woodley United FC saw greater opportunities for the provision of local football if the clubs were to amalgamate. As such a "One Woodley" steering group was created in April 2014 and has overseen proceedings so that from 2015 – 16 the three clubs have been playing under the Woodley United FC name.

The objective of the club is to "offer everyone in our community the opportunity to play, develop and grow through football, regardless of race, gender, age or ability" and in so doing provide community based football that is the envy of the footballing world." To help with this objective the club is a FA Charter Standard Community Club.

The FA's National Clubs' Manager Mick Backle stated "The vision, ambition and purpose of the One Woodley project is an inspirational football model that places the players and its community at its core."

The club provides football from mini-kickers (pre-school), youth through to adult (male & female) and veterans and has gone on to further be presented the Wokingham Borough Sports Council annual award for Service to Sport in and the Community in 2015, 2017 and 2019. The club also has players of Reading FC Women's team, coach and manager the men's Saturday Step 7 Reserve side.

This season sees the men's 1st team play in UHlsport Hellenic League Division One East, the ladies team competing in the Premier Division of the Southern Region Women's Football League (Tier 5 of FA Women's football pyramid) and the Veterans playing in the Hellenic Veterans Premier Division following their Division One league title and league cup success last year.

Luke Axton-Hall Defence
Strong centre back who is good in the air. Comfortable with the ball and likes to play it out from the back. Has had spells at Bracknell, Finchampstead and Alton.



Max Swift Defence
Central defender who joined the club from Finchampstead in the summer and looking to break into the team and make the step up to the Hellenic league this season.



Jamaal Whight Defence
Experienced defender who joined the club in November 2019 from Reading City. Can play either right back or centre back.



Ryan Alexander Midfield
Experienced defender in his second season with the club having joined from AFC Aldermaston. Ryan's versatility sees him also comfortable playing in midfield.



Sam Guze Midfield
One of the club's longest serving players who broke into the first team on a regular basis last season. Has good vision and ability to pass the ball while also being able to play in a number of positions.



Freddie Barron Midfield
Previously at Sandhurst Town and Finchampstead. Can play central midfield, on the wing and is comfortable at right back. Direct player with excellent workrate. Good with ball at his feet and likes to run at players.



Harry Hawkins Midfield
University of Reading student who joined the club in October 2018 winning manager and players' player of the year awards. Talented midfielder with an eye for a defence splitting pass.



Teddy Thomas Midfield
In his fourth season with the club, Teddy has skilful feet and a quick turn of pace that he uses to good effect on the wings and to score some spectacular goals.



Harry Swabey Midfield
Strong, aggressive player who can play up top or on the right wing. Chips in with goals and is quick. Last club was Finchampstead and also played at Bracknell.



Sam Wood Midfield
Tough tackling player who joined Woodley part way through last season from Eversley & California. Has the potential to be a major part of the team's midfield.



Adam Barnard Midfield
Vocal central midfielder who is strong in the tackle. Great work rate and a real team player. Previously played at Finchampstead and Sandhurst Town.



Lamin Ceessay Midfield
A pacy tricky player who is comfortable on either wing. Joined the club in November 2019 from Bracknell Town.



Ben Anderson Forward
Another product of the club's youth system. Ben is a strong forward whose pace causes opponents problems.



Max Laschok Forward
Tenacious forward who harries defences and finished the team's leading scorer in his first season at this level having joined part way into the campaign.



Toby Briggs Forward
Toby is a big strong forward who is excellent with his back to goal. Has a good touch and quick feet and improves with each season.



Jamie Williams Manager
Appointed Manager of the team in November 2019. Previously managed the club's Reserve side and worked with a number of our youth teams.

Chalvey WMC Sports • Club History

The "Stabmonks" were founded in 1885 and apart from a brief break in the early 1980's Derek Macklin reformed the club in 1986.

In the early days Chalvey used to play in the Great Western Combination although little is known about the club's progress back then. From 1950 up until the early 1990's, Chalvey competed in the now defunct Slough & District League & over that time the club registered several wins in various senior cup competitions including The Slough Town Senior Cup and The Norfolkian Senior Cup.



In the 1980's the club were based in the Garibaldi Pub in Chalvey. After a change in landlord, the football club moved to Chalvey Working Men's Club and we then added the W.M.C. to the club name for sponsorship reasons.

The Slough & District League folded after the end of the 1991/92 season and merged with The East Berks Football League and Chalvey were placed in Division 1. Chalvey won that league at the first attempt and were then promoted to the Premier Division for the 1993/94 season and won the title 1996/1997. During this period the club had more success in cup competitions and won the East Berks League cup on three occasions and runners up three times. Chalvey have also won the Norfolkian Senior Cup, Ascot & Fielden cup and were runners up twice in the Slough Town Senior Cup.

In season 2016/2017, the first team moved to compete in the u/sport Hellenic Football league in Division 2 East in a season that saw the first team win its first league championship in 20 years with 4 matches to spare. It was a feat that was repeated in season 2017/2018 when we retained the League championship we won the year before and

were runners up in the Slough Town Senior Cup. During season 2017/2018, the first team reached a groundshare arrangement with both Slough Borough Council & Slough Town Football Club and saw us play our home matches at the magnificent Arbour Park Stadium. This move has now allowed us to take our deserved promotion to play at step 6 of the National League System for the very first time. This has also allowed our Reserve team to move across from the East Berks Football League to play in The u/sport



Hellenic League Division 2 East for season 2018/2019.

On a bitterly cold Tuesday evening, Woodley made the short trip to Aldermaston. The two previous encounters between the sides were close affairs and tonight's match proved no different with a single goal scored by the hosts in the fourteenth minute settling the tie.

The early stages saw an Aldermaston cross from the right punched clear by United keeper Craig McCreeth before a strike from distance sailed over McCreeth's crossbar.

Woodley's first chance fell to Sam Wood. Gaining possession just outside the box after a short corner, the centre midfielder's shot took a slight deflection, forcing Lee Johnson in the home goal into a smart stop in the left corner. Moments later Joe Sissons volleyed over after another corner.

Fourteen minutes on the clock saw the only goal of the game and it came from a United mistake. An under-hit pass was intercepted by Karl Simms whose pinpoint cross from the left found Jamel Forde-Small who thumped home from close range.

The away side were lucky not to fall further behind midway through the half when another dangerous cross from Simms flashed across Woodley's six yard box, whilst a back-pass and miss-kick nearly saw the score doubled in calamitous circumstances.

After another Wood strike was saved, United had the ball in the net when Max Laschok coolly finished into the right corner after a long free kick was flicked on. Unfortunately the linesman had his flag up for offside.

On thirty three minutes, Woodley were forced into an early change when Joe Swaine replaced the injured Sissons.

The new arrival immediately tested Johnson with a cleanly hit strike that was saved. United kept creating chances. A fantastic ball picked out Lamin Ceesay on the left. Taking the perfect touch, the winger went one on one with Johnson who he rounded; running out of room, his cross from the tightest of angles was blocked by a defender. The resultant corner was worked to Ceesay who went down in the box with no penalty given.

Aldermaston had the half's final chance. A well hit Simms free kick was tipped over by McCreeth.

The last few minutes aside, only one team looked like scoring in the second period and that was the visitors. A rampaging run down the right by Harry Swabey ended with a shot blocked. A second change was made on fifty two minutes and once again it was because of an injury. Harrison Moore replaced Swabey at full back.

The next two chances saw Laschok involved in both. The first saw him fire over after cutting in from the left. The ball did take a horrible bobble on a dreadful surface as contact was made. The second saw him pull the ball back from the right byline to Ben Anderson who forced a routine save from Johnson.

After an ambitious Toby Briggs strike from distance whistled past the angle of post and bar, Woodley came within a couple of inches of levelling the scores sixteen minutes from time. The move was started by Laschok who did well to shrug off several challenges; a couple of passes later a Swaine effort from the left of the box cannoned back off the woodwork.

With the match in its final five minutes, Aldermaston had chances to seal the win. A substitute shot over from the right of the box whilst another effort was well saved by McCreeth.

In injury time Laschok rolled in Briggs on the right of the box; unable to get full control, the ball broke back to Laschok who had his strike well blocked.
