CLUB HISTORY

Woodley United FC was formed in 2011 as a result of four Woodley based football clubs and Berks & Bucks FA recognising that the provision of women's and girls' football in the town would be better provided by one club dedicated to this purpose rather than the existing clubs each having one female team to satisfy FA Charter Standard needs but no player progression policy.



During its time as a female club, Woodley United FC saw success on and off the pitch. This included coaching in schools, supporting the Woodley Community Carnival inter school tournaments, being presented the Wokingham Borough Sports Council annual award for Service to Sport in and the Community in 2014, winning four Berks & Bucks FA County cups and the Southern Region Women's Football League league cup.

Such were the benefits of working together that two of the town's oldest clubs, Woodley Town FC and Woodley Hammers FC in conjunction with Woodley United FC saw greater opportunities for the provision of local football if the clubs were to amalgamate. As such a "One Woodley' steering group was created in April 2014 and has overseen proceedings so that from 2015 – 16 the three clubs have been playing under the Woodley United FC name.

The objective of the club is to "offer everyone in our community the opportunity to play, develop and grow through football, regardless of race, gender, age or ability" and in so doing provide community based football that is the envy of the footballing world." To help with this objective the club is a FA Charter Standard Community Club.

The FA's National Clubs' Manager Mick Backle stated "The vision, ambition and purpose of the One Woodley project is an inspirational football model that places the players and its community at its core."

The club provides football from mini-kickers (pre-school), youth through to adult (male & female) and veterans and has gone on to further be presented the Wokingham Borough Sports Council annual award for Service to Sport in and the Community in 2015, 2017 and 2019. The club also has players of Reading FC Women's team, coach and manager the men's Saturday Step 7 Reserve side.

This season sees the men's 1st team play in Uhlsport Hellenic League Division One East, the ladies team competing in the Premier Division of the Southern Region Women's Football League (Tier 5 of FA Women's football pyramid) and the Veterans playing in the Hellenic Veterans Premier Division following their Division One league title and league cup success last year.

Thame United • Club History

Thame was formed in 1883 making it one of Oxfordshires' oldest clubs. Its early years were spent in Oxfordshire Leagues and in 1906, 1909 and 1910 Thame won the Oxfordshire Senior Cup and the Senior League in 1907, 1908, 1910, 1930 and 1931. A switch to the Hellenic League then brought further success culminating in the Hellenic League title in 1961-62 and 1969-70, as well as being runners up in 1960-61, 1976-77 and 1980-81.



The Oxfordshire Senior Cup was won in both 1976 and 1981 but a poor spell in the mid eighties preceded a crossing of the pyramid in 1988-89 to join the South Midlands League. The Club finished runners up in both 1988-89 and 1989-90 before eventually winning the title in 1990-91. Thame received the green light to join the Diadora League in 1991/92. 1994-95 saw the Club win the Division 2 Championship with 93 points - an 11 point margin. In 1995/96 the Club reached the 3rd Round Qualifying in the FA Cup and the FA Trophy. In the league we finished a creditable 13th in our first ever season in the Isthmian League Division One. Andy Sinnott was appointed first team manager in June 1997 and, with a dramatically reduced operating budget, the side were relegated into Ryman Division Two. The Club bounced straight back into Ryman Division One and reached the semi-finals of the FA Vase. 1999/2000 saw the Club come within two points of achieving promotion to the Premier Division.

2000/2001 season the team lead the way for most of the season, putting together a club record of 12 consecutive league wins but a slump in form in the latter part of the season resulted in a 5th place. A mid-table finish followed in 2001/2002 season but the Oxfordshire Senior Cup was retained. Mark West was appointed player/manager when Andy left United during the Summer of 2003. In October 2003 the club reached the 4th qualifying round of the FA Cup for the first time in its history, before being beaten 1-2 by Conference side Farnborough Town. After a mid-table finish the Club moved to the newly formed Southern League, Division 1 West. In October 2004 the Club again reached the FA Cup 4th qualifying round and finished the season 11th in the league. Mark West left to join Slough and defender Tony Joyce was appointed player /manager.

By July 2005 the Club were in financial trouble and, following a visit from Bailiffs acting on behalf of HMRC, the landlord enforced a clause in the tenancy agreement and evicted the club from Windmill Road. A ground share agreement was reached with neighbours Aylesbury United and, with the side struggling at the foot of the Southern League Division 1 West, Tony Joyce resigned in December 2005, with a new joint managerial partnership of Richard Searl and Alan Thorne appointed. Relegation to the Hellenic League was confirmed later in the season. A ground share agreement was reached with AFC Wallingford for the 2006/07. Mark West returned to the Club mid-way through the season but could not save the Club from relegation to the Hellenic League Division 1 East. The 2007/08 season provided greater stability for the Club, with Mark West and new assistant, Frank Thompson, looking after first team affairs. A mid-table finish resulted, which was followed by a ninth placed finish in 2008/09. 2009/10 saw the Club win the Division 1 East title by six points and reclaim their place in the Premier Division.

The 2010/11 season was the most significant in the Club's recent history. With work on a new £3.1m ground at Meadow View Park commencing in March 2010, United returned to Thame at the ASM Stadium on 11 December 2010, just over five years after their enforced eviction from the town. Boasting eight pitches, a floodlit 3G training pitch and 8000sqft clubhouse, United now have one of the best sporting facilities in the Hellenic League. The official opening against Oxford United on 18th January 2011 set a record crowd of 1,382. In the last two seasons, under the stewardship of Mark West and Stuart Blaik, United have finished fifth and sixth in the Premier Division

The contest at Risborough was always going to be tough. Backed by a crowd of over 100, the hosts recovered from an early Woodley goal with a dominant second half showing to extend their league record to an impressive eighteen wins and two draws from twenty games.

After an early shot by Rangers went wide, a fantastic crossfield ball by United's Lamin Ceesay found Max Laschok on the left. Getting to the ball before the keeper the forward's lobbed effort landed on the roof of the net. In the next attack, Laschok and Ceesay combined again after a clipped ball down the right touchline. This time the former turned provider squaring to Ceesay who placed a low shot into the left corner from ten vards.

Following a goal mouth scramble that saw the away side hack clear, Ceesay missed to the right from the left of the box.

Risborough were a very physical team, with the majority of their side well over six foot. A corner from the right saw a Joel Read header clip the top of the bar. Following a sustained period of pressure. Woodley keeper Craig McCreeth did well to punch clear a left wing cross moments before Rangers had a goal ruled out.

United were looking to hit their opponents on the counter using their pacev wide men. Another fine ball from left to right saw Ceesay pick out young winger Josh Millo, who was making his first start for the first team. After a couple of nice touches. Millo passed to Laschok who rolled in Ceesay whose shot from a tight angle on the left was blocked for a corner

There was a big let off for Woodley on thirty eight minutes when a dangerous cross was inadvertently turned towards his own goal by right back Jamaal Wright. Showing excellent reflexes McCreeth did superbly to palm away the ball destined for the left corner.

United's advantage only lasted for another sixty seconds as almost immediately after the save McCreeth was beaten by a low shot from Sam Pekun whose celebration was even better than the finish. Despite defending well for large periods. Woodley went into the break behind after Brian Haule fired home after a left wing corner wasn't cleared.

The second half started frantically with United clearing off the line and a golden chance at the other end spurned when Ceesay failed to control a ball that would have seen him go clear through on goal. Woodley were immediately punished on fifty one minutes when Haule smashed home after the ball broke to him on the left side of the box. Two minutes later Haule completed his hat-trick despite the best efforts from McCreeth who got a hand to a header that went into the top right corner following a header back across goal.

After a couple of half chances for Laschok, one that went wide and the other blocked, a miserable thirteen minutes for United ended with Josh Fox rounding McCreeth and rolling into an empty net from a tight angle. Just after the hour, Harry Hawkins shot over after being teed up by Ceesay as Woodley attempted to get back into the match. A United double change took place on sixty six minutes when Tommy Boyd and Ben Anderson replaced Sam Wood and Millo.

The home team were relentless and much more impressive than the game earlier in the season when they narrowly won. Some excellent play on the right by Pekun saw him beat his man and fizz a cross in that Kyle Faulkner couldn't convert

Woodley made their final change with fourteen minutes to go when Pele Hagger made way for Bailey Hill at left back. With the match entering the final ten minutes, McCreeth pulled off a sprawling save to deny Pekun a second. The scoring was then completed sixty seconds later when Pekun unselfishly squared to Faulkner who couldn't miss from close range. The final chances fell to United. Hawkins saw an effort blocked whilst Toby Briggs blazed well over in added time.
