- provide a duty of care
- Abide by all rules, regulations, and codes of conduct and policy, including child

- protection and care for vulnerable individuals, concussion protocols, and payment
- policy

Code of Conduct for Volunteers

- Develop an appropriate working relationship with performers, based on mutual trust
- and respect.
- Make sure all activities are appropriate to the age, ability and experience of those
- taking part.
- Promote the positive aspects of the sport (e.g. fair play)
- Display consistently high standards of behaviour and appearance
- Follow all guidelines laid down by Scottish Rugby and Madras Rugby Club
- Never condone rule violations, foul play or the use of prohibitive substances
- Encourage performers to value their performances and not just results
- Treat all participants with respect including players, referees and spectators
