- Improved cash-flow on recent years but not as improved as I hoped.
- Bar profit has decreased mostly because we had to pay Belhaven £4000 sponsorship back when switching suppliers to St Andrews Brew Co.
- Bar wages have increased by £4000 because Cat the Clubhouse Manager has taken a £4000 wage.
- Membership income has increased because we increased memberships prices this year.
- Clubhouse Lets have increased because Cat Stephen has been facilitating more business.

Points of consideration:

- I think for the club to be sustainable our clubhouse manager (Cat) needs to be paid on an hourly rate for her work rather than £4000 per year for what is actually something like 15 20 hours/week.
- In order to cover these costs bar prices may need to go up.
- Membership prices increased by 40% across the club but we have only realized £2500 more in membership income??
- Thornton's have declined to contribute £2000 towards the Rugby Development Officer, this will be an extra expense that the club will have to cover for years to come.
- I am doing the clubs books free for the next two year before I resign as treasurer, saving the club £4000 for the next two years. The club has two year to become solvent enough to cover this future cost.
