



## Guidelines for dealing with an Incident/Accident

Emergency contact numbers are available on the register taken each training session/match.

- Stay calm but act swiftly and observe the situation. Is there danger of further injuries?
- · Listen to what the injured person is saying.
- Alert the first aider who should take appropriate action for minor injuries.
- In the event of an injury requiring specialist treatment, call the emergency services.
- In the case of junior teams deal with the rest of the group and ensure that they are adequately supervised
- Do not move someone with major injuries. Wait for the emergency medics.
- For Under 18s contact the injured person's parent/carer. For senior members use the emergency contact details.
- Complete an accident/incident report form.
