CLUB RULES

1. The Club shall be called "The Swindon

Town Hockey Club."

2. The object of the Club shall be the playing of men's and women's hockey according to the rules of the Hockey Association.
3. The Club shall be affiliated to the Wiltshire

County Hockey Association and the Wiltshire Women's County Hockey Association.

4. Every candidate for membership shall be

elected by the Committee and all members shall abide by the Rules of the Club.

5. The Annual Subscriptions shall be as

follows:-Playing Members ... Junior Playing Members ... (Under the age of 18 and £1 10s. 0d.

Students)

Non-playing Members ... 5s. 0d.

In the case of Playing Members and Junior
Playing Members these Subscriptions shall be
reduced by 10s. in each case if paid before 1st
December in each year, on which date all subscriptions shall be finally due and should be paid
to the Hon. Treasurer.

6. The Annual General Meeting, of which at

The Annual General Meeting, of which at least seven days' notice shall be given to every member, shall be held on a date to be fixed by the

Committee, when the Accounts shall be passed and the Officers of the Club shall be elected.

7. The Officers of the Club shall consist of a President, Vice-Presidents and the following who shall be the Committee: Hon. Secretary, Hon. Treasurer, Men's and Women's Fixture Secretaries, Men's and Women's 1st XI Captains and Vice-Captains and Men's and Women's 2nd XI Captains and Vice-Captains.

Club Rules (contd.)

8. The Committee (three of which shall form a quorum) shall supply any vacancy that may occur in their number, have the sole management of the Club and its property, decide any question upon the construction of these Rules or anything relative to the Club not provided by them, and determine the penalties for infringement thereof. The Committee shall have power to delegate to one or more of its members its powers in relation to the arrangement of matches with other clubs, the selection of teams and the organisation of social events.

The Club colours shall be for men tangerine and white, and for women tangerine and black.

A Special General Meeting shall be called by the Hon. Secretary at any time on a requisition of six or more members in writing, who must state the object of such meeting. In the event of non-compliance within 14 days, the said members shall be empowered to call such meeting them-selves, repeating in the circular convening the meeting the statement made to the Hon. Secretary.

11. A member may be expelled from the Club by a resolution passed by two-thirds of the members present at the Annual General Meeting or at a Special Meeting for that purpose specially convened of which due notice shall be given to each member.

12. No new rules or any alteration in these rules shall be made except at the Annual General Meeting or at a Special General Meeting called for the purpose. Any such amendment must have a two-thirds majority of members present and entitled to vote and a quorum of 12 members is required.
