#### "SEMPER ACCEPTUS"

Last year, the Festival took place in fine though dull weather, which enabled the full programme of sixty-eight games to be played. Twenty-three teams took part, including newcomers in the Esandars from Bristol, The Cardinals from Oxford, the Wodens from Wednesbury, the Sleepers from the G.W.R., London and the Midwives from Sanderstead, Surrey.

A hearty welcome is extended to the following new teams this Easter:—
Hawks, The Bath Buns, The Bounders, The Facreys, The Knight
Hawks, The Sorceres, The Vikings and The Berkshire Boars.

None the less welcome are the many teams who have taken part in the Festival for a large number of years and whom we are always glad to see again.

Eight pitches were used last Easter, and for the first time Torquay participated in the Festival. Four pitches were used there, and with a great improvement in the Paignton pitches also, the playing surfaces last year showed a tremendous step in the right direction. Thanks are due to the Paignton U.D. Council for making this improvement possible.

With regard to the pitches, the Committee wish to express gratitude for the co-operation of the local Borough of Torquay and the Divisional Education Officer. This has resulted in the provision again of five pitches this year, although it is still not possible to use these wholly throughout the Festival. We have again had to solicit aid from Dartington Hall and the Commanding Officer of the Junior Signals Training Corps at Denbury, and assistance has again been willingly forthcoming. This means a little travelling into the highways and byways of South Devon, but we trust that the short journeys involved are compensated for by the playing surfaces

There is still a shortage of Umpires, and we wish to ensure that each game will be properly supervised, so Captains and Secretaries are asked to make certain that one of their members attends with the chosen team prepared to take a whistle if the need arises. This must be considered an important and essential Rule throughout the Festival.

More teams than ever before, twenty-nine in number are taking part this year, and we hope that all who attend will thoroughly enjoy themselves, both at the social functions and on the playing field during the week-end.
