

Coaching Strategy 22-23 Season

Context

- Swindon Hockey Club has undergone significant growth since moving to new facilities at the Deanery School in 2019. These achievements include:
 - Promotion of Men's 1st XI to West Prem in 19/20 and finishing mid-table in 21/22
 - Promotion of Ladies 1st XI to West Prem in 19/20 and securing prem status in 21/22
 - Men's 2nd XI securing promotion to Div 2 East in 20/21 by winning Saxon Division 1
 - Ladies 2nd XI had a strong season, finishing mid table and developing lots of juniors
 - Men's 3rd XI securing promotion to Saxon Division 1 by finishing 2nd in Saxon Division 2
 - Formation of Men's 4th XI for 22/23 season



Context

• The on pitch successes have highlighted a need to create a coaching strategy, including an internal player pathway, to build on the foundations laid by the successes of the previous 3 seasons and to ascertain the club's position as the premier hockey club in Wiltshire.

• This strategy is intended to run for the 22/23 season, with a long term strategy to be developed for the following seasons.

Training Sessions

• Swindon Hockey Club takes an unique approach to scheduling training sessions. Assigning players to a training session on ability, as opposed to team. This ensures that training sessions reflect the appropriate standards with the sufficient attendance, acknowledging that not all players are able to train at specific times due to other commitments.

Player Pathway

JUNIOR SECTION



DEVELOPMENT TRAINING

A player new to the club that has not played hockey before would attend Players returning to the sport after a long absence would also attend

Juniors transitioning to the adult section would be expected to attend for first 2-3 months



CLUB TRAINING A player new to the club that has played recently at a local club would attend

A player returning to the sport after a moderate absence, that has played at a high standard previously A junior demonstrating an above average ability may attend if agreed with coach prior A junior or adult that has developed their skills in the development training may attend if recommended by coach



PERFORMANCE TRAINING

A player new to the club that has played 1st XI hockey recently may join this session if agreed with coach prior

Invited 2nd XI players are also able to attend (extended to all M 2nd XI)

Juniors demonstrating an exceptional level of ability and fitness are able to attend if agreed with coach

Club players demonstrating high levels of ability should also be invited on a trial basis
