



PAULTON ROVERS FC– COVID 19 guidelines for all Visiting Teams Committee Members/Directors and Visitors.

Track and Trace

- All visiting clubs must supply their name and contact details to Paulton Rovers Secretary (preferably before the game by email) of all Directors/ Committee Members, players and other persons travelling with the team for track and trace purposes.
- The Club bar staff will be responsible for taking full details of all other supporters / visitors who will be entering the club / stadium when purchasing the entry ticket for the stadium.
- No equipment must be passed around or shared this is to include pens.
- **Entrance to the Stadium / club**
- Stadium Capacity from 24th August -30th August as been set by the FA at **200 persons**
- As From 31st August, using the 2 metre distancing requirement the capacity We can accommodate in the stadium is **210 persons**
Standing 166, Main stand, 18 Lower Stand 26,
- Entrance to the stadium for All First Team & Youth Games will be via the ticket office (and only once they have purchased an entry ticket and provided track and trace details as above)
- A Sanitiser station is situated Inside the entrance to the Stadium
- Entrance /exit to the clubhouse will be via the Main entrance at the front of the club house.
- Everyone must use the hand sanitiser provided at the entrance to the club, when coming in and out of the club house.

Takeaway Drinks

- Hot and cold takeaway drinks will be sold either in the club house or Tea Bar in the stadium (if Open). No glasses to be taken out of the club house
- The Tea Hut counter will be sanitised on a regular basis throughout the game
- Ideally card payments only; if handling cash, hands must be sanitised thereafter.
- The Tables in the club will be sanitised once the person/persons have left the table.

Kit and Personal Belongings

- No Kit bags or equipment and personal belongs must be taken into the Club House

Toilets

- Both the Ladies & Men's toilets in the clubhouse and stadium will operate a one in & one out policy.

Players Changing Rooms

- Sanitiser units are placed in the tunnel and the away dressing room and should be used on entry/exit.
- Home team will enter the changing rooms via the tunnel only **6 players** allowed at one time and only **2 showers** to be used. The away team will enter & exit via the emergency exit at the side of the changing block
- Only 2 Officials will change in the dressing rooms at any one time

Pitch Protocols

- Match Official "warm up" areas will be marked out with poles in front of the dug outs.
- Match Officials will conduct their meeting between both managers on the pitch
- Pre match team meetings will take place on the pitch
- Extra seating will be provided in an extended dug out area to provide adequate distancing for all the substitutes.
- The goal posts will be sanitised at half time
- No hand shaking or goal celebrations should take place
- Home team water bottles will be individually numbered for each player and will be sanitised /sterilised after each game
- If a ball goes out of play it should only be retrieved by a game participant or Paulton Rovers designated stewards, in breaks of the game replacement sanitised balls will be provided and all the other balls will be sanitised ready to be used
