The role of parents and carers within Southwell Brincliffe United LHC is a very important one

Parents and carers have a big influence on the manner in which the clubs players conduct themselves. It is therefore very important that the parents and carers set an example in terms of their conduct and expect all members of the club to follow that example.

Southwell Brincliffe LHC expects Parents and Guardians to abide by the following code of practice:-

- Complete and return the Health and Consent Form for your child
- Deliver and collect your child punctually from coaching sessions / matches
- Ensure your child is wearing suitable clothing / shoes and is properly attired for the weather conditions.
- Encourage your child to learn the rules of Hockey and play within them. Teach them that they can only do their best
- Support your child's involvement and help them enjoy the sport
- Help your child to recognise good performance, not just results
- Never punish or belittle a child for losing or making mistakes
- Never force your child to take part in sport
- Discourage unfair play and arguing with officials
- Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding the good performances of all.
- Behave responsibly on the sidelines
- Publicly accept judgements made by officials
- Acknowledge the importance and role of the club coach. Show appreciation and support the coach
- Use correct and proper language at all times
- Be patient **AND** realistic
- Encourage and guide players to accept responsibility for their own performance and behaviour
- Do not film or photograph any training sessions or matches without prior approval of the session organiser

Discipline within the club is taken very seriously and will be dealt with by the Club Disciplinary Officer and in accordance with the club constitution.
