INTRODUCTION

AS A SPECTATOR

- Refrain from indulging in loutish behaviour.
- Never, unless authorised by the Touchline Manager, enter the Field of Play during the course of a match.
- Always accept the decision of the match officials.
- Never assault or act aggressively to any person(s).
- Always adhere to behaviour standards outlined in this Code of Conduct and of the spirit of the game.
- Never behave in a way which disturbs the enjoyment of the match by any other person(s), or brings discredit to the home club, the league and/or the game of rugby league;
- Always refrain from acting in such a way as to exhibit intolerance towards individuals or groups, due to their gender, age, race, disability, religion, faith, sexual orientation or any other visible or non-visible difference, either by language or other conduct, to any other person(s).
