Job Description

An exciting opportunity has arisen to join the developing medical team at Teddington Rugby.

There are opportunities to support the:

1. **Junior squads** (U18-U12) for injury clinics (1-2x weekly) and match-day cover (Sunday)
2. **Women's squad** for match-day (Sunday) medical cover and training sessions (1x weekly) locally in Teddington
3. **Men's 2nd XV squad** on match-days (Saturday) for pitch-side medical cover at our home ground in Bushy Park and away fixtures within Surrey.

The individual(s) we are looking for will be reliable, professional with excellent levels of communication and should be comfortable working within an adult and/or junior rugby environment. This position is supported by the Head of Medical, Director of Rugby and club management team.

These roles would involve supporting the club for the 2023-2024 season, starting from September 2023, until April/May 2024. We would favour applicants who are able to commit to a set number of hours, however this can be modified based on your availability and other full-time work commitments.

**Responsibilities:**

- Support with pitch-side first aid and injury treatment.
- Support with and occasionally lead the concussion management process when new concussions or suspected concussions occur in matches or training.
- Run club-wide injury clinics and support with treatment and rehabilitation plans.
- Contribute to the injury management, injury prevention, physical rehabilitation, education and medical services delivered to our men's, women's and junior players.
- Maintain accurate and detailed medical records of all aspects of treatment, injury management and rehab content in keeping with governing guidelines.

Essential:

- BSc in Physiotherapy, Sports Therapy, or Sports Rehabilitation.
- Professional registration (HCPC, MCSP, SST, BASRaT) including insurance.
- Qualified to provide emergency and trauma pitch-side care (ICIS level 2 or 3, ITMMiF or ATMMiF) or working towards - opportunities for partial-club funding option over time.
- Competent in sports taping (ankles, knees, shoulders, etc) - internal training can be arranged.

Desirable:

- Previous experience working in sport and/or rugby.
- MSc in Physiotherapy, Sports Therapy, or Sports Rehabilitation, or working towards.
- Active driving licence with access to a car.
- Keen to engage in and support the medical team with regular first aid/trauma management practice scenarios.
