- **5.3.** Add "Committee Members" to list of those members entitled to vote at General Meetings as set out in Rule 4; i.e. "All Life Members, Vice Presidents, **Committee Members**, Full Members and those Junior Playing Members aged sixteen years or over at the date of the meeting are entitled to vote at General Meetings. Other members may attend General Meetings but are not entitled to vote.".

6. Subscriptions and Match fees
