Kit

For matches:

- All your personal kit should be marked with your name.
- Clean comfortable fitting footwear, toiletries and a towel if required.
- Gomersal Cricket Club shirt and cricket trousers.

For cricket practice:

Under 11's-17's

- White shirt, tracksuit bottoms or cricket trousers and trainers during practice sessions. Should also bring a cricket bat and a cricket ball (Under 11 & 13's 4¾ oz)(Under 15 & 17's 5¼ oz).
- Protective equipment including an abdominal protector (box) and a helmet fitted with a grille or faceguard <u>MUST</u> be used.
- Parents are responsible for ensuring the face guard grille is adjusted correctly to prevent a ball from
 penetrating the viewing area left between the helmet neb and the top edge of the grille. Any failure to
 comply may lead to unnecessary delay, which in turn could reduce time allocated for the incoming
 batsman
- If unsure, please ask coach for advice.

Under 9's

Cricket white top/ tracksuit bottoms and trainers.

All youths or juniors:

- Do not wear any form of jewellery.
- Do not bring any unnecessary valuables.
- Do not bring any unmarked kit!
