Code of conduct for Supporters and Spectators

- Do not use profane language or harass referees, coaches or players. Verbal abuse will not be tolerated. This also applies to behaviour inside the clubhouse on match days or at any club function.
- Stay off the pitch unless given specific permission by the referee.
- Ensure compliance with rules on smoking inside the clubhouse.
- The club will take disciplinary action if necessary, against any individual who contravenes the code of conduct

Code of Conduct for Parents/Guardians

- Encourage your child to learn the rules and play within them.
- Discourage unfair play and arguing with officials.
- Help your child to recognise good performance, not just results.
- Never force your child to take part in sport.
- Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding the good performances of all.
- Never punish or belittle a child for losing or making mistakes.
- Publicly accept officials' judgements.
- Support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy their sport.
- Use correct and proper language at all times.
