WRUFC - Proposed "virtual" AGM (30 June 2020) - Postponement

As everyone will be aware, we were proposing to try to hold an AGM by Zoom on 30 June. RFU guidance encourages clubs to hold meetings virtually, if workable, but also recognises that, in the COVID environment, it might be necessary to delay AGMs until it is possible to meet up in person.

Since the proposal for a virtual AGM was put forward, a number of members have expressed their preference for a face-to-face AGM and this sentiment may explain the low level of take-up for the proposed Zoom meeting which would mean that the quorum requirement for the meeting would not be met.

Accordingly, the decision has been taken to postpone the AGM until such time as we can meet in person. Notwithstanding this, the key information / reports etc that would have been 'tabled' at or advance of the AGM will be circulated to members for information and we will also put these on the website. Current committee / volunteer roles will continue until the next AGM although, if anyone does wish to get involved and help in any capacity, please do contact one of the current committee members (a list will be put on the website).

Given the postponement, we will also look to put out a more general newsletter to members ahead of the coming season to update everyone on the ongoing work relating to Bridge Lane and Grappenhall and on the plans for next season generally.
