### Orrell v Winnington Park Saturday 19th March 2022 Match Report



Just after the start of the game, a series of pick up and drives took Orrell into the visitor 22, but they then gave a way a penalty. The penalty resulted in a Winnington Park line out in Orrell's half and another penalty enable the visitor to win another line out close to Orrell's 22 from were Winnington Park moved the ball across the field to score the first converted try of the game.

The kick from the restart when straight into touch, giving Winnington Park the put in at a scrum on the halfway line. The visitor then moves the ball quickly out to the wing and kicked forward along the ground, enabling Winnington Park winger to outpace the Orrell defence to score their second converted try, with less than 10 minutes played.

Several minutes later after Orrell gave away another penalty and the visitor extended their lead to 17 points with a penalty conversion.

Midway through the half a high tackle by Orrell enabled Winnington Park to take a quick tap of the ball and move it along their backs and another kick along the ground resulted in them touching down for their 3rd try. Despite the missed conversion, the visitors still had 22 points lead.



A series of pick up and drives took Orrell into their opponent's half where they got a scrum. They then moved the ball to the short side and winger Matt Stott touched down for Orrell's first try. Chris Brand converted the try - Orrell 7 Winnington Park 22.

5 minutes later the visitors were again 22 points in front when again they moved the ball quickly across their backs to touch down in the corners for their 4th try and conversion and a bonus point.

With 5 minutes left to the break, Orrell had the put in at a scrum, but lost the ball enabling Winnington Park to run in their 5th try which was also converted.

In the last few minutes of the half, a good break by prop Josh Grant, put the opposition under pressure and when the ball was passed back to Centre Chris Brand, he cross kicked it, enabling winger Liam Fowler to collect the ball and score in the corner. Chris Brand converted to make it Orrell 14 Winnington Park 34 at Half Time.

Just after the restart Orrell give away another penalty which their opponents converted making the score 14 - 37. 10 minutes later Orrell turned over the ball at a ruck and moved the ball out to winger Liam Fowler to outpace the visitors to touch down for his second try in the corner. Chris's conversion attempt hit the Up Wright and bounced out making the score Orrell 19 Winnington Park 37.



Just before midway through the half the visitors had a scrum and then moved the ball to score try number 6 which was unconverted. 19 - 42.

With less than 20 minutes left in the game Orrell were reduced to 14 players when Wing forward David Wane was Yellow Card only to be followed 3 minutes later by Prop Brad Roden. Orrell did manage to stop Winnington Park extending their lead when they were down to 13 players, but just before they were back to a full 15, the visitors kicked a penalty to increase their score to 45 points.

Winnington Park were reduced to 14 players for the remainder of the game after being Yellow Carded.

A good break by replacement wing forward Tom Campbell took play into the visitors 22 and after a number of pick up and drives prop Josh Grant forced his way over the line to touch down for Orrell's 4th try for a bonus point. The try was converted by Matt Stafford to make the Final Score Orrell 26 Winnington Park 45.


