

THE FIRST HUNDRED YEARS:

A WHISTLE-STOP TOUR

The present Rochdale Rugby Union Football Club was formed in 1921 at a meeting in Smith's Café at Townhead, Rochdale.

Our first home pitch was on a ground at Firgrove which we stayed at for two seasons. Our very first home fixture was versus Keighley.

We then moved to Balderstone where we spent the next fifteen seasons. It was here that the real foundations of the Club were laid and new players were recruited. Fixtures and results steadily improved, spectators flocked to the ground and a stand was built. The success however was almost destroyed when Rochdale Corporation purchased the land for development.

The Club relocated to the Moss on the hills above Norden. The ground was rather remote and the facilities were at best meagre. As always, we tried and so a 'bath house' was built consisting of 6 large beer barrels cut in half and a wood burning stove.

Following the stay at Norden (interrupted for six years by the war) the Club Committee was authorised to purchase a new ground. This process began in 1948 when we bought our home here at Moorgate Avenue for the sum of £1,400. An appeal was also set up to enable the purchase to be completed, carry out the levelling, provide washing and changing facilities and an entertainment area. For all this we needed £3000!!

Saturday 22nd September 1951 was a huge day for the Club as we played our opening match at our new home. The opponents were Heaton Moor and our lads won 17-6.

In 1952 we converted an expanse of the water holdings, grass covered, composted clay into playing pitches. The cost of conversion of the new first XV pitch was £650 with an additional £175 for extensive drainage and a stand that was built.

Throughout the 1950s, 60s, 70s and 80s the Club progressed with improved fixtures, increased playing numbers and constant improvements to the available facilities. In those days fixtures were classed as friendlies and old friends tended to stick together. We ran, by end of the mid-1970s, 4 teams: a 1st XV, an A Team, a B Team and a Vets team known as the Wasps.

This continued until 1985 when the RFU introduced the league structures we are familiar with today.

The league structure comprised of 11 levels from the very top to the bottom. Initially we were placed in Level 7 and over the years we have been as low as level 9 and as high as level 5.

We have also won the Lancashire Trophy 5 times and have produced players at various representative levels within our sport.

The 2nd, 3rd and 4th teams were included in the league structure in 2002 and have reached their own highs of Premier League, Division 2 North and Division 3 North respectively. A recent welcome addition to our teams is a ladies' section which is now beginning to thrive.

Our Club has also been honoured over the years with 2 of our members being chosen as presidents of Lancashire RFU. Disaster struck when an arsonist targeted the Club in 1990 and burned the clubhouse down. However good came from bad when we decided to 'go big' and we built a new clubhouse which included new changing facilities, a function suite for over 200 people, various bars and even, for a time, an Italian restaurant. This building served us well for over 20 years.

We then decided in 2002-2003 to replace the old clubhouse with a brand new one at the other end of the 1st Team pitch. This was made possible by selling an area of land on which the old clubhouse was sited to housing developers. The end result was the magnificent clubhouse we all enjoy today which opened in 2005.

However, we must mention the Club's 47 1st XV captains, 15 presidents, 10 Chairmen, 1000's of players and members, 1000's of volunteer's, 100's of staff who have made it all possible. Creating memories for us all. Today, Rochdale RUFC is an RFU accredited club and remains true to its original values as a welcoming, fiercely competitive but amateur rugby club promoting rugby's core values of teamwork, respect, enjoyment, discipline and sportsmanship.

That's our journey: 100 years in a nutshell.

THE FUTURE:

KICK-OFF TO THE NEXT HUNDRED YEARS

So, what of our next one hundred years?

After a couple of attempts we successfully established a Mini and Junior section in 1980. This has prospered over the past two decades and grown to be one of the most successful junior clubs in the north west and which today comprises boys' and girls' teams from under 6 years to Senior Colts. This we see as the bedrock of the Club's future.

With this in mind we aim to expand into what is currently the Rochdale Company of Archers' building that adjoins our clubhouse.

The Rochdale RUFC Centenary Legacy project will be to create a new indoor rugby facility, hopefully 2-storey and to incorporate new fitness and training facilities with extra changing rooms on the ground floor and with a fully equipped gymnasium and medical facilities on the 1st floor. Details of this exciting project will be circulated in due course to encourage fund raising from all sections of the Club.

We invite all of our players, members, supporters, friends and families to join us and support us on the next stage of our journey.
