

## **Directions to Warrington RUFC**

Grappenhall Village Sports Club (also known as South Warrington Sports Club)  
Stockton Lane (Only accessible from Grappenhall/East end)  
Warrington  
WA4 3HQ

### **From the North/East/South:**

- M6 Junction 20
- Head towards Warrington.
- After 100 yards take second exit at round-a-bout signposted A50 Warrington.
- After 1.5 miles turn left down Chester Road at Traffic lights (signposted A56 Stockton Heath, then Runcorn).
- After .5 mile turn left at traffic lights over Stanney Lunt bridge (signposted Grappenhall Village). This is a small hump back bridge, max load 6 tonnes.
- After 50 yards, take a sharp right hand turn down Stockton Lane (a sign will say the road is closed and is a dead end).
- The Club is ½ mile on the right hand side. The lane is narrow but there are a few passing places for cars.
- There is a large car park for over 130 cars, please do not park in the passing places or on verges, unless directed by marshals.

### **From the West:**

- Take A56 From Stockton Heath. There is no vehicle access from the West end of Stockton Lane as the road is closed half way along, prior to the sports club. Access is from the Grappenhall (East) end of Stockton Lane.
- Continue down A56 and turn right over Stanney Lunt Bridge to Grappenhall Village. This is a small hump back bridge, max load 6 tonnes.
- After 50 yards, take a sharp right hand turn down Stockton Lane (a sign will say the road is closed and is a dead end).
- The Club is ½ mile on the right hand side. The lane is narrow but there are a few passing places for cars.
- There is a large car park for over 130 cars, please do not park in the passing places or on verges, unless directed by marshals.

### **Long vehicle access:**

Most Sat Navs will route vehicles down the A56 from either East or West, then over Stanney Lunt bridge, which involves a sharp turn, narrow width and high hump back, with a maximum load of 6 tonnes. The turning after the bridge to Stockton Lane from this direction is even sharper, and involves doubling back down a narrow lane with parked cars down one side. This is not recommended for long vehicles.

### **Alternative access from M6 Junction 20:**

- Exit M6 Junction 20 towards Warrington A50.
- After 100 yards take first exit at round-a-bout B5356 (signposted to Stretton and Appleton)
- After ¾ mile there is another round-a-bout , take second exit (Broad Lane on Google Maps, marked as Grappenhall Lane on the ground), signposted to Grappenhall 1 ¾
- Go past Grappenhall Cricket Club on left and turning to Rams Head on right.
- Sat Nav will indicate you are now on Church Lane.
- After 50 yards, bear left on to Stockton Lane (a sign will say the road is closed and is a dead end).
- The Club is ½ mile on the right hand side. The lane is narrow but there are a few passing places for cars.
