

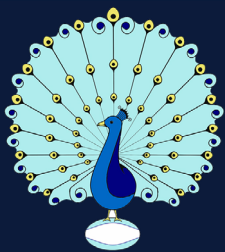

Bakewell Mannerians RUFC

Since its birth in 1928 our club has achieved much success both on and off the field, including numerous league promotions, cup wins & RFU accreditation. Amazingly all these milestones have been reached without the club having our own ground.

Player numbers have been falling at all levels in recent years due to a combination of lack of home fixtures (caused by waterlogged/unplayable pitches) and the attraction of clubs further afield with their own playing, training and clubhouse facilities. Being able to offer our own facilities has therefore become essential for the club to survive, grow and ultimately prosper in the future.

With the Club now in its 90th year, Bakewell Mannerians finally have a home of their own! This historic moment has been made possible by years of painstaking work by committee members, and thanks to the generosity of local landowner, Lord Edward Manners of Haddon Hall.

The club has gained its RFU Accreditation and the Sport England Clubmark. Essential steps to accessing the funding we need.

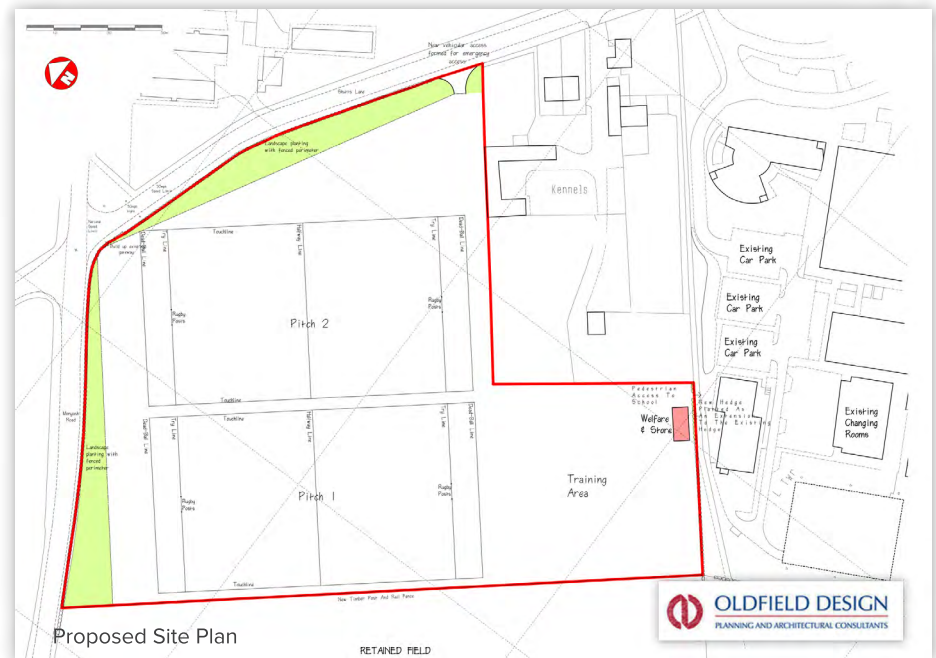
Shutts Lane Ground Development

The club has acquired the lease on land by Shutts Lane, Bakewell, adjacent to Lady Manners School. We now have planning permission to create two full sized rugby pitches, and a much needed welfare building.

The pitches must now be developed to a high standard in order to meet with Sport England specifications.

Our projected costs to develop the pitches are just short of **£190,000**, to include levelling and drainage. We must provide new access to the site, landscaping and screening, and connections to services.

Together with the provision of the welfare building, our overall budget stands at **£250,000**.



We have secured a grant of **£75,000** from Sport England, provided we can give evidence of the remaining partnership funding by August 2019. We are also assured of **£49,500** of funding via a section 106 agreement on an adjacent development of land at Lady Manners School. We have applied for an RFU Loan of **£50,000**, if granted we still need **£30,500** to reach our target.

This is why we need YOUR help to raise the remaining amount and achieve our goal!

Mini Mannerians

At Bakewell Mannerians we realise that the Mini and Junior age groups are the real future of our club. Mini rugby was re-established in 2004 and flourished for many years. Unfortunately recent seasons have seen a sharp decline in numbers and the near end of youth rugby in Bakewell.

Our recent land acquisition and renewed vision for the future, along with a partnership with **RuggerEd's** has seen a new beginning for our Mini's section this season. We now provide sessions every Sunday, either at the Medway Centre in Bakewell or at Lady Manners School (dependant on weather conditions.)

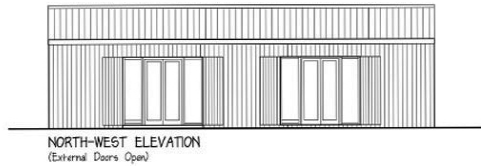
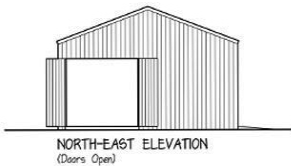

Proposed Welfare Building including Club Room and Storage

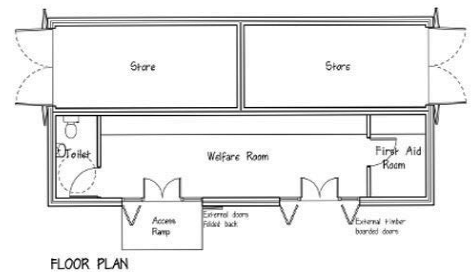
