Action from the 2013-14 Ellis Cup Final

Plymouth Argaum and Devonport Services have a long history in the cup, meeting regularly in both Combination and County Cup competitions. Argaum's first victory in the Lockie Cup in 1923-24 came at the expense of Devonport Services 'A'. The last time the Wanderers met Services III in the Ellis Cup was in the final itself in 2013-14 where the 'Sporting Blues' ran out winners by 16 points to 3 at Brickfields.

The Ellis Cup dates back over 25 years, the trophy having been presented to The Plymouth Combination by Roy Ellis, who played for a number of local clubs including Plymouth Argaum.
