Introduction:

Following the FA's announcement (17/07/20) which enabled competitive grass roots football to resume, Baldock Town FC have studied the published guidelines and produced this Plan & Risk Assessment to ensure all players, staff, officials, committee members, parents, carers and spectators at our games adhere to the policies and remain safe.

The FA's guidelines required each team to appoint a COVID-19 officer, their role is pivotal in keeping up-to-date with FA guidance, ensuring everyone understands and adheres to their responsibilities and ultimately allow football to continue in a safe environment.

Baldock Town FC's appointed **COVID-19 Officer** is currently **Ercan Mehmet** (we may add further officers at a later date).

This Plan & Risk Assessment is based on the FA's guidelines; however, we have also added in some practical policies of our own to ensure the safety of everyone comes first.

As a team that currently groundshares, we have aligned our home game policy to that of our landlords Arlesey Town FC.

This document is designed to allow football to resume for Baldock Town FC; it now allows for the return of spectators too and may require updating to align with any further guidance or rules that may be implemented in the future.
