- Play to the rules and laws of the game
- Play to enjoy Rugby, to play at your best, improve your skills and play well
- Never argue with the match officials their decision is final [even if you think they are wrong] accept it with good grace
- Respect the Club Officials, Coaches and Volunteers
- Respect your fellow team mates Rugby is a Team Game
- Respect your opponents
- Follow the rules of the game and take responsibility for your own actions on the pitch
- Pay towards any fines imposed by the RFU as a result of on pitch discipline (red cards)
- Attend any club hearings to explain your actions, after receiving a red card for poor discipline on the pitch
- Train to the best of your ability and attend training
- Be attentive in coaching sessions
- Do not swear or be abusive during Games or Coaching Sessions
- Recognise and appreciate the efforts made by coaches, match officials, parents and administrators in providing the opportunity to play at the club and enjoy the rugby environment
- Respect the facilities offered by the club, the Club House and its environment. This is your Club and everyone should do their utmost to keep it well maintained.... Do not bring mud, kit bags and dirty kit into the public areas. Do not put your feet on the chairs, walls or ceiling
