Car Parking Plan & Risk Assessments | Minis Rugby Festival April 23rd

Overview

Hemel Hempstead (Camelot) RUFC are anticipating 520 players plus 50 "others". With an emphasis on car-sharing, the club is provisioning for the parking of 540 cars across 8 separate car parking sites:

General

- All sites will be managed by a Head Marshal who will be an adult, contact details for each site marshal will be provided to the clubs.
- All Event Marshals will be wearing Hi-Vis Marshals vests.
- Detailed site locations will be provided to clubs including What three words reference and, where appropriate, arrival times + request to car share
- Each Head Marshal will be thoroughly briefed and provided with this document.

Note to Head Marshals

- Please familiarise yourself with the site plan and number of marshals you will require in your team
- NOTE: two sites require exit marshalling as well as entry (Boxmoor Trust Centre & Boxted Farm)
- Please assemble your own team from amongst your reliable and punctual friends, family, teammates and club members. You will need two team members to sell event programs
- Collect Hi-Vis Vests & Food/ drink tokens*, event programs, cash float and bucket from the club (in event we run out of Hi-vis please ensure team are wearing something with visible Camelot logo)
- Once initial car park phase is complete, please return to the clubhouse / event control sites to be redeployed (if required)
- Please collect Hi-Vis vest, buckets etc. after the event and deposit at the club 7pm, Friday 21st



Risk to Pedestrians / dog walkers	Marshals to slow / control speed of traffic within the car park Event marshaled from 08:15 – 10:30 and then peak exit 14:30 – 15:15
Risk to pedestrians on London Rd.	Park & Ride arrangements in place (4 min bus ride)
Risk of collision on London Rd	Exit incl. bus return will be left turn only up to roundabout to turn
Risk BMT staff unable to access/ move tractor	Barn and approach to be kept clear of vehicles
