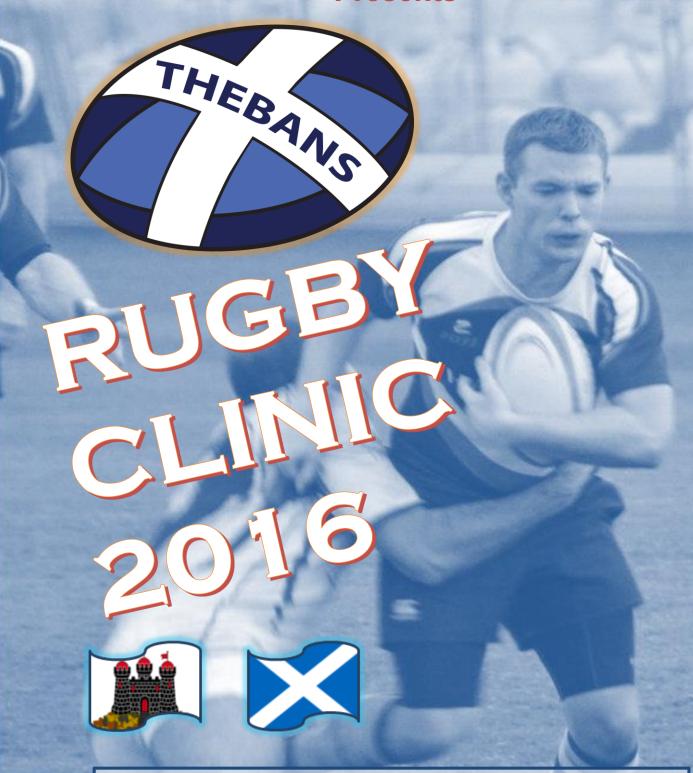

#### HOW TO GET TO MURRAYFIELD

The easiest – and quickest - way to reach Murrayfield is via Edinburgh's brand new tram system from St Andrew Square, opposite Harvey Nichols' department store.

Ticket vending machines and smartcard validators are located on every tramstop platform. You must buy a ticket before boarding a tram.

You can buy tickets using the easy to use Tram ticket vending machines, which feature touch screen displays to guide you through.

A single ticket costs £1.60 and a return costs £3.20. Ticket machines do not give change. A minimum of £3.00 is required to buy tickets using a card.

Pre-recorded audio announcements on board will let you know the next stop on the service, as well as safety messages and ticket information.

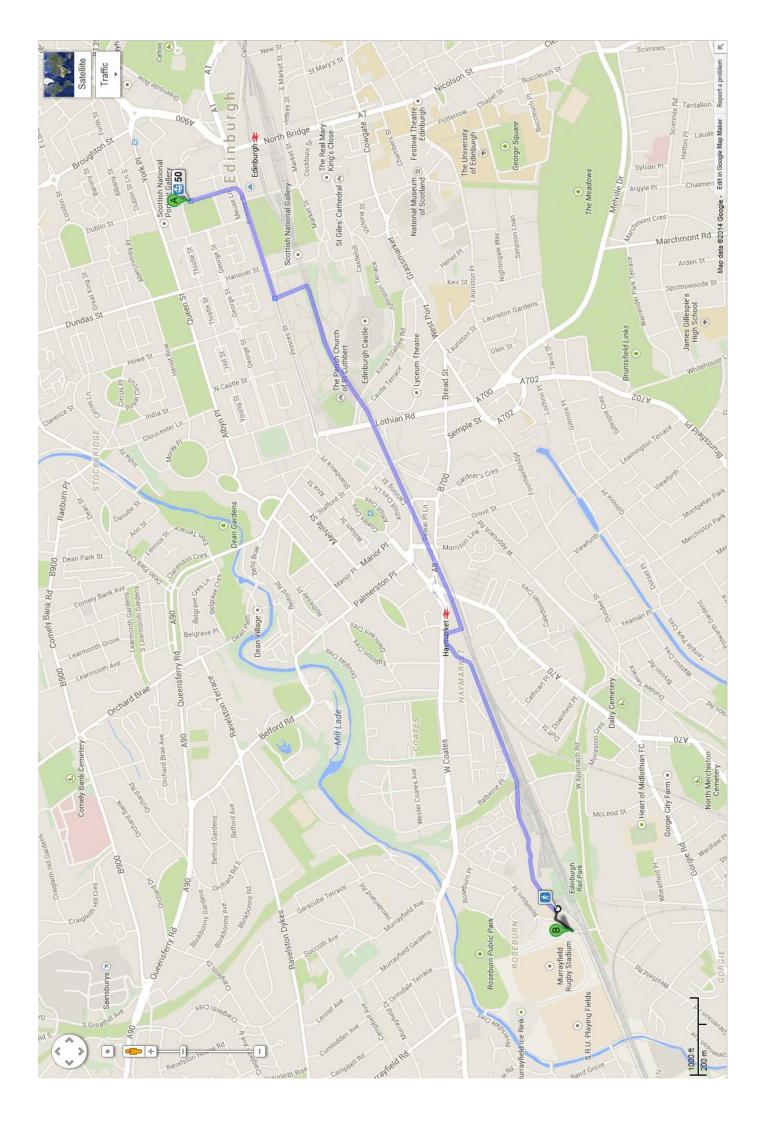
There are ticket inspectors on all of the trams. Make sure you have a valid ticket before you board or you will have to pay the £10 on-board fare!

The pitches and changing rooms are to the south-west side of the stadium, as you enter the main gate to Murrayfield. You will be guided to your changing rooms.









#### FOOD 'N' PHYSIO

We know how ruggers like their food and physiotherapy. To help turn you into big burly bruisers and to ease away the aches and pains from the Clinic, our partners at Caledonian Hospitality and ProActiv Physiotherapy & Sports Injury Clinic will be providing nourishment for body and soul over the weekend.

# **Caledonian Hospitality**

The Clubhouse Café, operated by Caledonian Hospitality, will be open on Friday night from 18:00 to 22:00 for burgers, hot chicken breast baguettes, chilli and nachos, and other snacks.

Breakfasts will be offered on Saturday from 08:00 to 11:30. Available options include hot bacon and sausage rolls, full breakfast buffet, porridge and fruit, croissants, teas and coffees.

The Café will also be offering some post-Clinic meals over the counter as retail on a first come, first served basis until sold out.

Please note, the Café will stop service at 18:00 as the Clubhouse is being turned around for Murrayfield Wanderers' annual Hallowe'en party.



Physiotherapy will be available on Saturday during the day by the delectable Del from ProActiv.

Please note, all physio work will only be for injuries that happen at the Clinic. No strapping or physio work will be done for preexisting medical conditions or injuries.

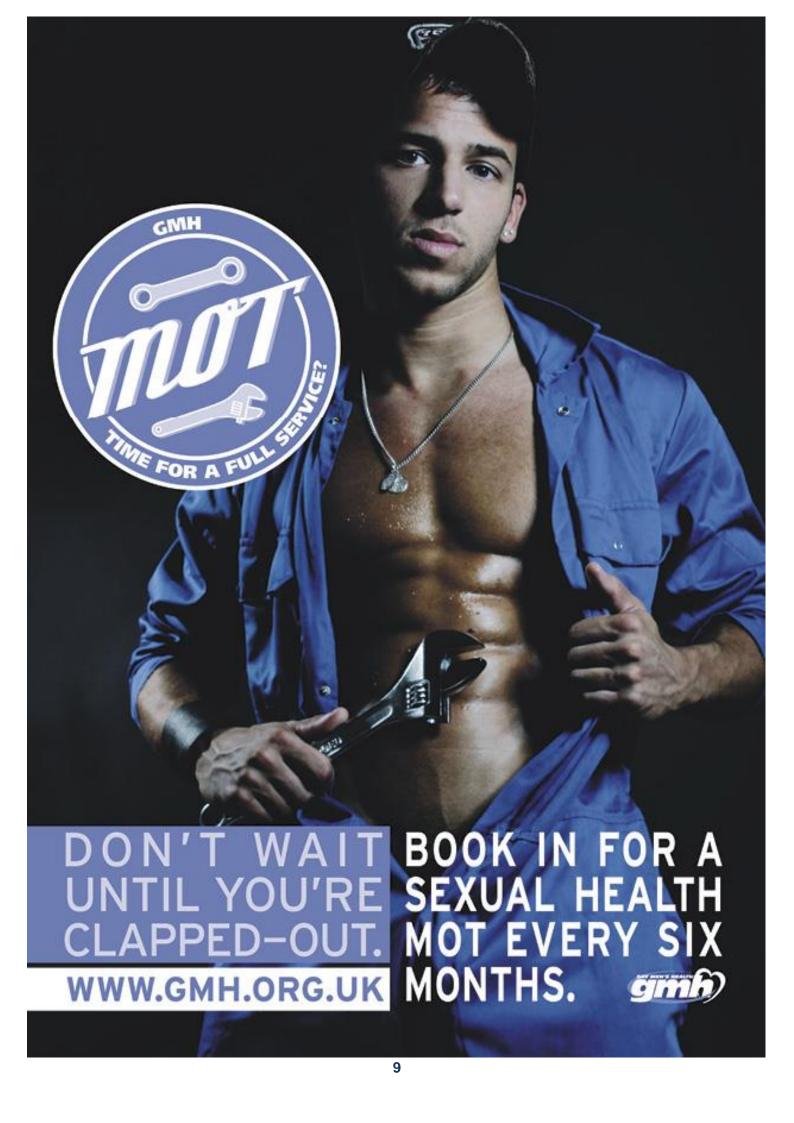
