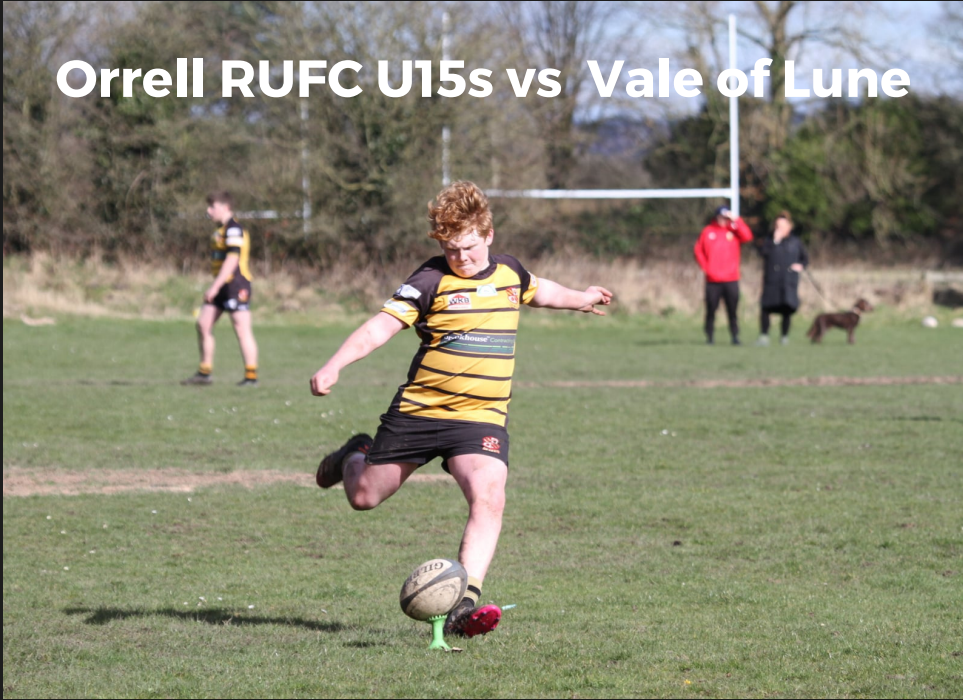

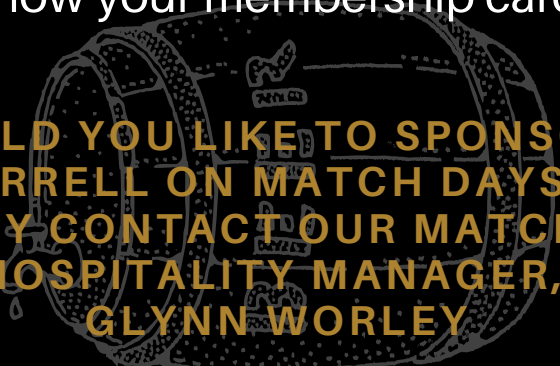

ORRELL RUFC VS BOLTON RUFC

Saturday, 5 March 2022

After a break of 2 weeks Orrell resumed play with a home fixture against Bolton. Early in the game Bolton intercepted an Orrell pass on the halfway line and quick passing of the ball resulted in them touching down for a converted try.

15 minutes into the match an Orrell high tackle enable the visitors to take a quick tap penalty close to their own line, they then kicked down field and regathered the ball to eventually score an unconverted try in the corner, to give them 12 points lead. Almost immediately from the restart Bolton moved the ball quickly across their backs to touch down for a second converted try. Orrell 0 Bolton 19.

Less than 5 minutes later at an Orrell scrum the home side were pushed off the ball and Bolton again quickly moved the ball along their backs to touch down for their 4th try for a bonus point. The conversion was missed, giving the visitors 24 points lead. With just over 10 minutes left in the first half, Bolton won the ball at a line out, and again using their backs, ran through the Orrell defence to touch down for their 5th try which was converted giving them 31 points lead.

For the last 10 minutes of the first half Orrell were reduced to 14 players when Second Row Andy Stott was Yellow Carded for a late tackle. However, Orrell manage to stop the visitor taking advantage of their extra player and the score remained Orrell 0 Bolton 31 at the break.

In the Second half Orrell's play improved and after 5 minutes from the restart, they turned over the ball in their opponents 22 to gain possession of the ball and after a series of pick up and drives Wing Forward Max Huxley scored Orrell's first try. However, a few minutes later Bolton started a move just inside their own half and quickly got the ball to their winger, who ran round the Orrell cover to touch down for their 6th try, which was converted, giving them back 31 points lead.

Midway through the half from a line out Prop Josh Grant drove the ball into the opponent's defence and when eventually stopped the ball was quick moved out enabling Orrell Centre Dylan Hartley to score Orrell's second try, which Chris Brand again converted to make the score Orrell 14 Bolton 38.

Although another good break by Dylan Hartley, put Orrell in an attacking position they were unable to capitalise on it and at full time the score remained at Orrell 14 Bolton 38.

Wigan had the advantage of the wind in the first half and a few minutes after the kick off Orrell were defending deep in their own half and gave away several penalties. Wigan quickly moved the ball from a penalty across the field to touch down in the corner for the first points in the game. The try was converted to give them 7 points lead.

Orrell continued to give away penalties and Wigan extended their lead with a penalty conversion after 7 minutes play. Wigan 10 Orrell 0.

About 10 minutes later Orrell had the put in at a line out close to their own line, but the ball got tapped down on the Wigan side enabling the home side, who took advantage of possession of the ball, to score their second converted try Wigan 17 Orrell 0.

Eventually, Orrell managed to move play into their opponent's half. and from a scrum the moved the ball out to the wing and when he was tackled short of the try line set up several pickup and drives for front row Josh Grant to force his way over for Orrell's opening try. The conversion was missed leaving the score Wigan 17 Orrell 5 - with about 15 minutes left in the half.

Wigan however were soon again on the attack and from a scrum they quickly moved the ball to their backs and broke through the Orrell defence to touch down between the post for their 3rd converted try with less than 10 minutes left before the break. Wigan 24 Orrell 5. There was however time for Orrell to mount another attack and from a scrum, No. 8 Dan Huxley pick up and drove into the Wigan defenders. The ball was recycled and a long pass out to winger Matt Stott resulted in him touching down in the corner for Orrell's second unconverted try to make the score at Half Time Wigan 24 Orrell 10.
