Conversion followed by Craig Thomas 0-7 to the visitors.

Tom Halsall finding his scoring touch, grabbed Orrell's 2nd after a defence splitting pass from James Ratcliffe. Not to out done by Tom, Chris Owen crashed over the try line after good work from forwards setting the platform for Adam Worley's pass to put Chris in at the same corner again.

Half time whistle Marple 0 Orrell 17 to the good.

A spirited opening to the second half by Marple delayed Orrell advancing and exchanges in the forwards and kicking from both fly half's saw the game seesaw in defence and attack. James Ratcliffe crafting the third try for Johnson with a kick to the left. Substitutions 2nd half allowed some game time for the returning Max Huxley, Andy Kelly, Alex Gaskell and Alex Glover. CHAIRMAN'S MESSAGE

TONY HAVLIN

Thanks to the vagaries of the league system we find ourselves with some quite long gaps between games. I am sure you are not happy with this and neither are we. The RFU are working with the clubs on another revision of the leagues for the next season. We have made our views known and we are still awaiting the outcome.

Last year was a busy year particularly on the land project and the pace and pressure will increase even more this year. We have completed the formalisation of our JV with WPC and now sit as the rugby section within Orrell & Winstanley Community Sports Club. This is in preparation for the commencement of the development of our new facilities in Winstanley Road which will start towards the end of this year. We continue to run our affairs and play as normal.

We had the inaugural AGM of the sports club on Monday the 4th of February. Both clubs were represented, and I am pleased to advise that Graham Winstanley was appointed as Vice Chair. The Board now has a vice-chair from both sporting sections. The minutes will be sent out in due course to all members. The ORUFC (rugby section) AGM will take place on Monday 13th May 2019 at Winstanley Tennis Club.

The introduction of new data protection laws (GPPR) has caused us some problems. In short, we lost touch with

some members for which I and the executive all apologise and those omitted should, by now, have received a letter & membership renewal notice. If you still haven't received anything, please contact our Membership Secretary, Janet Wilkinson, and ensure your details are correct and up-to-date.

Can I remind you once again that we need to get our own fund raising (i.e. in addition to grants money) to £200,000 over the next 18 months? We are half way there (once pledges are received) and so have enough money to start the land development phase this coming November. However we don't have enough money yet to complete all the work by our target date of July 2020.

Our registration of the Sports club as a CASC should be completed this financial year making any donations eligible for gift aid. We will soon be sending out letters to all those who have pledged donations to collect in the monies so that we can initiate the next stage of work on the project. We will also be sending donation forms again to all members that have yet to donate in the hope that there is still more to come.

WELCOME FROM PRESIDENT BILL LYON



A warm welcome to all our visitors and supporters this week.

With only a small number of games left to play it really emphasises the limitations of such a reduced league programme. Producing continuity and consistency in performance is now a real challenge for players and coaches. With training numbers consistently high, expectations regarding successful results and high league placings have grown considerably. Both teams are well placed and a top four finish is a very achievable goal.

The uncertainties regarding next year's league groupings are still under scrutiny involving the Northern Group, RFU and NW clubs from around level 6 downwards. After two meetings for consultation purposes, suggested structures will be put forward in February and something regarding a solution will be decided on by June. The numbers (low) in each league is a major concern along with travel distances

(particularly to Cumbria). The breakaway Lancashire Leagues (2) have taken 20 teams out of the frame and their position next year remains unclear. These two leagues are self-contained and advancement out of the higher league back into "mainstream" is not possible at the moment. One possibility is the status quo will continue for a further season before a revised programme is introduced (any bets on the situation being resolved before Brexit!)

No matter the outcome of these deliberations the players' focus is simply to finish as high as possible in their respective leagues. This will hopefully give a favourable place in any subsequent groupings.

As ever thanks for your support, please continue your support and involve others. Fund raising remains high on the agenda and every piece of support is incredibly important. Thank you. Bill

It is becoming apparent that the cost of hiring playing facilities is rising significantly, and it is highly likely that the Club will face a hefty increase in the charges next season.

Therefore it is extremely important that each home game's costs are covered by the sponsorship, which includes the match, the referee and the ball. We now have two successful Open Age teams and for 2019/2020 season and it would make financial sense to have every home game for each team fully sponsored. In the past the majority of games have been sponsored but going forward it is critical that all games are covered

Whilst awaiting the decision on the format of the leagues for next season and the number of home games it will generate it is proposed that the sponsorship level for the 2019/2020 season for both teams will be as follows:

Match £175. Referee £50. Ball £25.

A discount of 10% will be applied if all three options are taken together for the same match.

Planning for next season is already underway therefore if you wish to take up any of the above options please contact me either by email, by mobile or on match days.

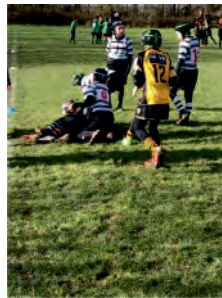
