The virus is spread in minute water droplets that are expelled from the body through sneezing, coughing, talking and breathing.

The virus can be transferred to the hands and from there to surfaces e.g. footballs, equipment goal posts. It can survive on surfaces for a period after transfer (depending on such things as the surface type, its moisture content and temperature).
