Parents/Guardians Code of Conduct

Parents should

- ◆ Ensure that their child is familiar with, understands and adheres to the Players Code of Conduct.
- ◆ Ensure that coaches are informed of any injuries or concussions that their child may have suffered
- ◆ Ensure that your child has suitable kit for training and matches and for the changing weather conditions
- Ensure players are **punctual** for both training and games and always make the coaches aware of availability for training and matches.
- Remember that young people play rugby for their own enjoyment and not that of their parents
- ♦ Focus on the players' efforts, rather than winning or losing
- ◆ Be realistic about the young players abilities
- ◆ Provide **positive** verbal feedback both during and after a training session or game
- ◆ Always show **appreciation** of good play by all young players from both your own club and the opposition
- Respect decisions made by match officials and encourage young players to do likewise
- ◆ Be aware of the HRFC Child Welfare and Protection Policy and always share concerns with club officials

Whilst the rugby is focused on the children learning and having fun, it is crucial that we have your commitment and that you feel part of the club. We have a number of social functions and fund-raising events throughout the season so please look out for these and come and meet the coaches and everyone away from the pitch side.
