

## **Market Harborough RUFC**

## Northampton Road, Market Harborough, LE16 9HF

## **Directions & parking**

Situated on the south side of Market Harborough adjacent to the A508 (Northampton Road), access is via the roundabout that leads to the leisure centre. Having left the roundabout bear left on the service road where you will see a large open car park. Ahead is the football club, to your left in the car park is the rugby club which has additional parking.

Please lift-share if you can as the parking does get full every week meaning late arrivals will be street parking in the surrounding area. Although the council car park is free to use, they still enforce parking outside marked bays with tickets.



<u>Pitches & changing rooms</u> There are 7 full pitches plus additional marked tag pitches. On the walls of the clubhouse are 2 whiteboards which will show where each age group is allocated to play. There are 6 changing rooms which will be allocated for the older age groups (under 13 and upwards).

Pitches 1 to 3 plus the tag pitches are immediately in front of the club house. The other four are to the right of the hedge. Access to them is via a gate to the right of pitch 3, or from a pathway at the end of the council car park. (See site plan overleaf)

Timing Unless told differently, U6-U12 age groups meet and commence warm-ups at 10am, Junior boys (U13-U16) are 11am kick-offs, warm-up on allocated match pitch beforehand. Junior girls' matches are 2pm kick-offs with warm up before on allocated pitch.

<u>Refreshments</u> Our kitchens are open to sell a variety of breakfast items, burgers, chips etc. and hot and cold drinks. The licensed bar opens at 11am. Players are provided with a free pasta meal after matches.

**Shop** The club shop sells club clothing and merchandising but also sundry items such as mouthguards or protective wear if players have come without their own.

**Dogs** Please do not bring your dogs as they are not allowed on any grassed area within our site.
