CODE OF CONDUCT FOR THE GAME OF RUGBY IN SCOTLAND

CODE OF CONDUCT

Introduction This Code of Conduct is the "World Rugby Code of Conduct", amended only in so far as is necessary to apply to the game in Scotland. Scottish Rugby is obliged to adopt the World Rugby Code and to ensure it is observed by all those who participate in the game within its jurisdiction.

The Code Scottish Rugby's Code of Conduct shall apply in respect of all clubs, schools, teams, players, coaches, match officials and other persons connected in any way with the game in Scotland.

All of whom: -

- (1) must ensure that the game is played and conducted in accordance with disciplined and sporting behavior and acknowledge that it is not sufficient to rely solely upon the match officials to maintain those principles.
- (2) shall co-operate in ensuring that the spirit of the Laws of the Game is upheld and refrain from selecting players guilty of foul play.
- (3) shall not repeatedly breach the Laws of the Game.
- (4) shall accept and observe the authority and decisions of the match officials and all rugby disciplinary bodies.
- (5) shall not publish or cause to be published criticism of the manner in which a match official handled a match.
- (6) shall not publish or cause to be published criticism of the manner in which World Rugby, Scottish Rugby or any disciplinary body handled or resolved any dispute or disciplinary matter resulting from a breach of the World Rugby Byelaws, the Laws of the Game, World Rugby's Regulations Relating to the Game, Scottish Rugby's competition rules or any other Scottish Rugby Byelaw, rule, regulation, policy or process.
- (7) shall not engage in any conduct or any activity on or off the field that may impair public confidence in the honest and orderly conduct of a match, tour, tournament, or series of matches (including, but not limited to, the supply of information in relation to the game, directly or indirectly, to bookmakers or to persons who may use such information to their advantage) or in the integrity and good character of any person.



- (8) shall not commit a breach of Scottish Domestic Regulation 6 (Betting and Anticorruption).
- (9) shall promote the reputation of the game and take all possible steps to prevent it from being brought into disrepute. Dyce Rugby Club Code of Conduct for the Game (Season 2022-23)
- (10) shall not commit a doping or other offence as defined in Scottish Domestic Regulations 21.1 (Anti-Doping) or 21.2 (Illicit Drugs); Scottish Rugby Code of Conduct for the Game (Season 2023-24)
- (11) shall not abuse, threaten, or intimidate any match official, whether on or off the field of play.
- (12) shall not use crude, foul or abusive language or gestures towards other players, coaches, club officials, match officials, spectators, or any other person.
- (13) shall not do anything which is likely to intimidate, offend, insult, humiliate or discriminate against any person on the grounds of their religion, race, gender, sexual orientation, colour or national or ethnic origin.
- (14) shall not do anything which adversely affects the game of Rugby, Scottish Rugby, any member club or other Union of World Rugby or any commercial partner of the game in Scotland; and
- (15) shall abide by all rules, regulations, codes of conduct and policies issued by Scottish Rugby including, inter alia, Scottish Rugby's Child Protection Policy, Concussion Policy and Player Payment Policy; Each club, player, coach, match official and other person connected in any way with the game in Scotland shall be under an obligation to comply with this Code of Conduct. Breaches of the Code of Conduct shall constitute acts of Misconduct under Scottish Rugby.

Every person is under an obligation to comply with this Code of Conduct. The Scottish Rugby Union is obliged to monitor compliance with and impose sanctions for breaches of the Code of Conduct by persons under its jurisdiction. For breaches of the Code of Conduct, the Discipline Panel of Scottish Rugby may impose such penalties as it deems appropriate.
