COACHING – Nicky advised that James McKinney is very interested in assisting with coaching. To carry this out he needs to complete a coaching course – Phil has been looking into this and will send a link for coaching courses to Jimmy and see what is suitable for him. At the moment it is hoped he can assist Guy with training the boys on a regular basis.

<u>STRIPS</u> – we are looking into getting new strips – Nicky and Fats will be having a trip to Turriff to check these out – more details to follow. We will still be getting canterbury shorts as they are the best make and fit.

MATCH FEES – Sean will be the Match Fee Collector

This year it has been decided club fees will be as follows;

This is to be worn AFTER EVERY GAME and before the game you must wear your club polo shirt. If you need a club tie speak to Andy Fowler – normal ties are £10- tartan anniversary ones are £15 THERE WILL BE A £2.00 FINE FOR FAILING TO FOLLOW THE DRESS CODE

CLUB INSURANCE – it was decided to take out the ENHANCED level insurance – Mobie to arrange

<u>CLUB DEVELOPMENT PLAN</u> – This is an ongoing development plan that will keep us up to date with SRU rules etc and will be worked on over the next few seasons.

BANKING – Nicky will be added as a counter signature. Sean will receive all information regarding banking from Phil – any enquires re banking now go to Mobie, Sean or Nicky.

<u>FIXTURES</u> – Fats to organise referees for each game (Ted Coutts) and also speak to Sport Aberdeen to sort out letting before each home game. He will make sure the fixture list is sent to Sport Aberdeen for every game.

A problem at the moment may be the changing rooms as due to covid restrictions a maximum of 8 players are permitted at one time. This may change before we start but Fats will have a look into how we can make this work and report back.

Also at the moment a risk assessment needs to be carried out for the changing rooms etc. Mobie is getting Keira to look into the forms but before entry a temp check will be carried out – Guy and Duncan will be asked to look into this and make sure all relevant forms are filled out.

<u>SCIP</u> – this is set up between us and the SRU and needs filled out and sent back – Phil will arrange – this enables us to apply for money from SRU and can bring in an income of around £3000.00 so worth doing.

<u>FUNDING UPDATE</u> – From the money we received previously for the SRU we have arranged pitch maintenance – this is paid for this year and the next two years.

We are also arranging to get the posts painted and realigned at a cost of £814.00 – Phil advised to go ahead and book

We are also looking at lights for the container – Phil looking into this

Another project we would like to start is upgrading the school changing rooms – this would not only benefit the guys but also the school – we have money put aside for this and Phil is going to speak to Sport Aberdeen and hopefully get the ball rolling on this very soon.

Also it has been mentioned speaking to the active school co-ordinator about starting an after school rugby club – we would fund this for a number of weeks and hopefully gain advertisement and word of mouth for the club and maybe future players

We also have quite a large amount set aside for a social media recruitment drive /sponsorship – please all have a think and if there is anything you would like to put on the social media or any ideas you have please let us know – anything is worth trying. We have paid for a digital expert to help over the next few months so lets use his expertise while we have him.

Andy will look at putting up more signage / banners around Asda area.

RECRUITMENT – a never ending subject – we are looking into the possibility of promoting the club at NESCOL collage and SRUC- Craibstone Campus – we could get promotional items made to hand out and invite guys to come to training and meet the team. If anyone has any other ideas for recruitment, please pass them on or if you would be interested in helping with this promotions please volunteer.

We are also looking at the possibility of business cards that can be handed out promoting the club at any occasion – Phil to liase with Digital guy on this and will report

DOG MESS – again an ongoing issue round the pitch, Sean has reported this and the fact the bins are always overflowing to the council – he is awaiting a response – will update
