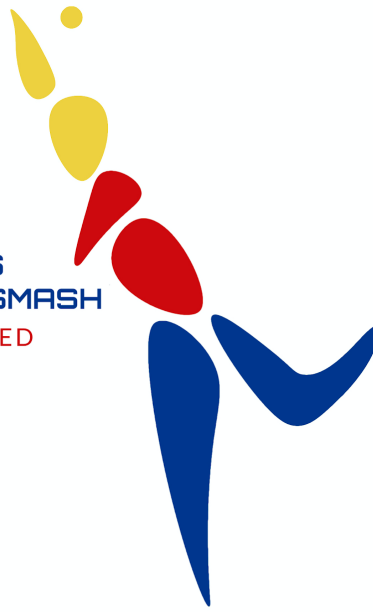

## Introduction

- Welcome to the Savills Sevenoaks Smash – The Hundred!
- The Savills Sevenoaks Smash will be replacing the long standing Clark Trophy competition for the Sevenoaks District Area. Traditionally a 15 over format, we will be revamping the competition to play the new Hundred Ball format.
- Games will be played on Wednesday and Thursday evenings beginning at 5:45, with a Finals Day on Friday 20<sup>th</sup> August in Sevenoaks Vine's Cricket Week. We have factored in a few weeks between the semi final and Finals Day to allow clubs to organise their team.
- We are extremely excited to announce that Savills (<https://www.savills.co.uk/estate-agents/savills-sevenoaks.aspx>) will be sponsoring the competition for the next three years!
- We are also extremely excited to partner with Invicta Cricket Coaching (<https://www.invictacricketcoaching.co.uk>), Clubbie (<https://www.clubbie.com>) and Stag Cricket (<https://www.stagcricket.co.uk>)
- We ask that each team brings their own umpire and scorer for their games to help with proceedings- we are more than happy for this to be a volunteer (e.g. a Parent). Neutral umpires will be provided for Finals Day.
- Each team will play three group games. Following the group stage, the top two teams in each group will proceed to the Cup Competition, whilst the bottom two teams will proceed to the Plate Competition.

- Traditionally, the competition aims to raise money for a local charity. We will continue this tradition by supporting both Hospice in the Weald and Kent Air Ambulance.
- Although we are not charging for the organisation and running of the competition we would ask that clubs look to make a donation. Our suggested donation is £100 per club.

- We will be playing with pink balls, provided free of charge by Sharks Cricket.
- We further encourage all teams to wear coloured kit if they are able to! For cheap kit options, we recommend Sharks Cricket ([www.sharksclothing.co.uk](http://www.sharksclothing.co.uk)) who will provide designs free of charge and a playing shirt, trousers and cap for £30

# Knockout

## Cup Competition

Round of 16



- The same seeding logic will apply for the Plate competition for 3rd and 4th place teams in their groups
- The highest seeded team will be the home side unless the highest seeded team does not have a ground available

## **Schedule**

**Gameweek 1:** Wednesday 9th June/ Thursday 10th June

**Gameweek 2:** Wednesday 16th June/ Thursday 17th June

**Gameweek 3:** Wednesday 23rd June/ Thursday 24th June

**Round of 16:** Wednesday 7th July/ Thursday 8th July

**Quarter Finals:** Wednesday 21st July/ Thursday 22nd July

**Semi Finals:** Wednesday 4th August/ Thursday 5th August

**Finals Day:** Friday 20th August - Plate Final (13:30), Cup Final (17:00) at Sevenoaks Vine CC - these are approximate times and we will confirm closer to the day

For the Knockout Section of the competition, we will work with teams to establish a fixture date if there is a conflict of day preference and if a ground is unavailable.

All games have been scheduled for a 17:45 start - unless agreed otherwise between clubs, this should be the start time to allow for players to travel from work and to complete fixtures before it gets dark.

# **Rules**

## **Squad Rules**

- Due to the variety of teams in the competition, we want to make games as competitive as possible. Subsequently, we encourage all Kent Cricket League sides to field a competitive Midweek XI consisting of a range of players across all teams at your respective clubs.
- Players should only represent one team throughout the tournament

## **Game Rules**

- 100 balls per innings.
- A change of ends after 10 balls.
- Bowlers deliver either five or 10 consecutive balls
- Each bowler can deliver a maximum of 20 balls per game.
- A 25-ball powerplay start for each team where two fielders are allowed outside of the initial 30-yard circle
- Maximum of 5 players outside fielding ring for rest of innings
- Batsmen must retire at 50\* and may return at the fall of the ninth wicket.
- All no balls will be given a free hit
- All wides will be determined by using the painted tramlines and have an extra ball bowled
- For the purpose of time, there will be no leg side wides.

## **Competition Rules**

- Three points will be awarded for a win
- One point will be awarded to each team in the event of a tie or abandonment
- In the event two or more teams finish on equal number of points in the group, standings will be determined by net run rate
- In the event two teams cannot be separated on net run rate, head to head will be used to determine seedings.
- In a knockout fixture, a tie will lead to a 5 ball bowl off to be bowled by 5 different bowlers. If no winner is determined after 5 balls bowled, this will go to sudden death.
- In a knockout fixture, a cancellation/abandonment will see the highest seeded team go through to the next round.



- On finals day, if a fixture cannot be completed due to an abandonment, the result will be determined by a 5 ball bowl off. If a bowl off cannot be completed due to weather conditions, the result will be determined by 1) Net Run Rate Across the Competition or 2) Coin Toss

## **Covid Compliance**

- It is our expectation that the fixtures of the competition will be subject to ECB and Government Covid regulations
- We ask all clubs and venues to abide by these regulations for the safety of all players, officials and spectators.
