## GUIDLINES FOR DEALING WITH AN ACCIDENT/INJURY

- Keep calm, act quickly and assess the situation e.g. is there danger of further injury? Check ABC - Airways - Breathing - Circulation
- · Reassure the casualty, listen to what they are saying
- Alert the First-Aider who should take any appropriate action for minor injuries
- In the event of an injury requiring specialist treatment, call the emergency services
- Ensure an appropriate person is delegated to reassure and supervise the rest of the group
- On no account move someone with major injuries, keep them calm and reassured and wait for emergency services
- Contact the injured person's parent or guardian
- First-Aider or Coach to complete the accident/incident report form as soon as possible following accident
- A form is to be completed for both home team player and visiting team player, top copy to be given to the parent/carer and yellow copy to be place in 'Accident Report' File
- Team managers/coaches to ensure this information is completed and filed in the 'Accident Report file' which is located in the club main office
