Big Sips from Blue Monkey 4.0% ABV

Pale Golden Hoppy Beer brewed mainly from Brewers Gold hops, very fruity and bitter

Flipping Best from Flipside 4.6% ABV

A traditional dark brown best bitter, strong malt flavours with good bitterness and gentle hop taste

Lady Julia from Grafton 4.3% ABV

A crisp golden ale with a floral hop aroma

Dog from Idle 4.2% ABV

Copper Ale with a good balance of malt and hops which lead to a better finish

Hop On from Kings Clipstone 3.9% ABV

Pale refreshing beer with a fruity aroma

Midnight Porter from Maypole 3.8% ABV

Rich Creamy dark porter with coffee raisin and chocolate flavours

Little Weed from Maypole 3.8% ABV

Deep golden in colour with subtle bitterness

Rich Ruby from Milestone 4.5% ABV

Lightly hopped with malty berry finish

Pride from Newark 3.7% ABV

A light hoppy brew

Pale Ale from Pheasantry 4.0% ABV

A pale coloured smooth tasty beer floral and citrus notes and a dry finish

Robin Hood from Robin Hood 4.0% ABV

A traditional ale, light brown in colour with a smooth dry finish

Roaring Meg from Springead 5.5% ABV

Smooth and sweet, citrus honey aroma and a dry finish

Henrietta 3.6% ABV

Low strength beer but crammed full of hop character

From Lincolnshire

Holbeach High Street from Austerdyke 4.5% ABV

Old fashioned dark best bitter

XXXB from Batemans 4.5% ABV

A blend of malt, hop and fruit on the nose with a bitter bite over the top of a faintly banana maltiness that stays the course. A true russet tan brown classic

Resurgence from Blue Bell 4.3% ABV

Brewed with Target hops giving a distinctive maltiness and a dry finish

Best Bitter from Blue Cow 3.8% ABV

A classic best bitter

Marquis from Brewsters 3.8% ABV

A well balanced refreshing session bitter with maltiness and a dry finish

Castle Dungeon from Cathedral Heights 5.4% ABV

A full bodied oyster stout

Deeping Jack from Hopshackle 4.0% ABV

Traditional amber bitter, fruity, malty and bitter finish

Kingston Topaz from Newby Wyke 4.2% ABV

Single hop ale with floral undertones

Alchemy from Oldershaw 5.3% ABV

A premium golden bitter, easy drinking with good hop aroma

Trembling Rabbit Mild 3.4% ABV

Rich dark mild brewed with local honey smooth malty flavour with slightly bitter finish

Crazy Kiwi from Sleaford 4.6% ABV

Red Brown bitter, fruit hop

Bouncing Bomb from Tom Wood 6.0% ABV

Rich ruby beer smooth to drink and keeps fruity hop character until the end, very moreish

Original from Willy's 3.9% ABV

Light brown beer with fruity tangy hop on the nose and taste giving a strong bitterness tempered by underlying malt

From Derbyshire

Light Rail from Ashover 3.7% ABV

Light colour and taste with initial sweet and malt flavours leading to a bitter finish and aftertaste

Special Pale Ale from Buxton 4.2% ABV

Light fruity and delicately hopped with a clear taste, a creamy mouth feel and nutty notes

Business as Usual from Derby 4.4% ABV

A easy drinking flavoursome copper beer, well balanced and smooth and malty satisfying finish

Brooklyn Heights from Hartshorne 5.4% ABV

A brown coloured ale with a complex malt assertive bitterness and a clean dry finish

Mash Tun Bitter from Leadmill 3.6% ABV

Well rounded classic English bitter

Hairy Helmet from Leatherbritches 4.7% ABV

Pale bitter well hopped but with a sweet finish

Honey Dragon from Middle Earth 4.2% ABV

A balanced golden bitter with honey notes

Solstice Summer from Raw 3.8% ABV

Deep golden beer sweet malty taste pleasant bitterness with citrus aromas

Shottlecock from Shottle Farm 3.6% ABV

Single malt beer brewed with local honey. Created from an old Victorian recipe for breakfast beer, in the summer the honey is replaced with Elderflower syrup

Twist and Shout from Spire 4.5% ABV

Creamy and dark with flavours of bitter chocolate and coffee. Easy drinking

Jaipur IPA from Thornbridge 5.9% ABV

Flavoursome IPA packed with citrus hoppiness that's nicely counterbalanced by malt and underlying sweetness and robust fruit flavours

Barrel Organ Blues from Wentwell 4.5% ABV

Golden brown full bodied premium bitterness with a rich malty flavour and aroma
