

Welcome to the New Croft for tonight's game, especially to the players, staff and supporters of Lakenheath. We come into the game off of the back of 2 defeats against Downham Town (0-1) and Mulbarton Wanderers (0-4) who were the teams 1st and 3rd when covid-19 halted last season back in March. Tonight we face the team who were in 2nd place. It's as tough a start to the season as we could expect but there have been some encouraging signs in our first 2 games, with a good all round display against Downham and a solid first 30 minutes of the game at Mulbarton on Saturday before 2 quick goals by the home side killed the game off. With the squad still getting to know each other and adapt to some tactical changes these first 3 games will stand us in good stead for when we play the teams who'll be around us in the table.

We are aware of the threat Lakenheath possess, especially with 2 of our squad from last season likely to line up against us in Tom Thulborn and Ryan Phillips, and they have started the season strongly with 2 wins from 2. However in the same fixture last season we gave a great account of ourselves and were unfortunate not to come away with at least a point in a 3-2 defeat.

Since my last programme notes I'm delighted to have welcomed Ryan Dewey into the squad. Ryan has played higher up the non-league pyramid and brings great experience and presence to what is a relatively young squad. His displays so far in central defence have been assured and he'll be a huge asset to the club. I'm also pleased to confirm that returning to the club is Craig Pruden who will be key to our attack throughout the season.

I hope you enjoy the game tonight, thank you for your continued support.

HBFC HISTORY....

Haverhill Borough were founded in the summer of 2011 under the name of Haverhill Sports Association. The club came into being when The New Croft facility was opened in Haverhill which allowed the opportunity for a club to groundshare with Haverhill Rovers FC. Haverhill SA took this opportunity with both hands and entered the Essex & Suffolk Border League (ESBL). After a few initial hiccups momentum was obtained and the club convincingly won promotion to the Premier Division and senior status. On their way to the title HCSA won an incredible 17 games on the trot and also amassed over 100 goals in the league campaign.

The club's first season at step 6 surpassed even the most optimistic supporters expectations; a few new signings pre season helped Borough towards an eventual 4th place finish., missing out on a third straight promotion by just two points. While sadly the FA Vase run was not repeated—a rematch against Norwich United, this time ending in a 1-4 defeat—success was had elsewhere, in particular with the newly formed Reserves, who won the Cambridgeshire County 2A League.

Season 2014/15 saw the club enter the FA Cup for the first time, and defeat two sides from hgiher—Barking, 1-0, and then Whitton United, 2-0—before eventually losing out to Ryman Premier side Leiston in the First Round Qualifying. The FA Vase again saw the Blues twice defeat higher-league opposition, while

The side also reached the semi final of the First Division Knock-Out Cup. Martin Westcott also took over from Ben Cowling as first team manager midway through the campaign, the latter moving to become the club-chairman. The Reserves also had a season to remember, the highlight being a 1-0 victory at Lowestoft Town Reserves in the Suffolk Senior Reserve Cup, while also reaching the semi final of the Creake Charity Shield.

In 2015/16 the progress of the club continued, with the reserves gaining promotion and the first team winning their first senior piece of silverware, courtesy of a 5-0 victory over Stowmarket Town in the First Division Knock-Out Cup Final.

The next season saw Borough promoted out of Division 1 after a stunning run of form. Winning 17 and drawing 1 our of the last 20 fixtures which included 10 consecutive victories which ensured Westcott's men achieved promotion on their final home game with a 13-1 win over Leiston Reserves.

2016/17 also saw the club move into their new 3G surroundings at The New Croft. The state of the art facility supports the whole community football agenda, where Borough are pleased to play their home fixtures.

HISTORY OF THE OPPOSITION

The 'Heath' was founded in the early years of 20th Century, around 1907-08. There's a bit of confusion as to our original colours as there are a few 'original' shirts still around including blue and gold stripes as well as black and old quarters. Since then we've changed a few times including green and gold quarters, green and white, blue and black stripes and lately yellow. This year we have gone back to our 60's colours of green and white.

We've had various 'homes' including somewhere close to the playing fields and also to the right of the old British Legion. We arrived at the 'Nest' around the time of the 2nd World War, when, after the chalk was quarried for the construction of various local roads, the land owner, Sir Charlton Briscoe, gave the quarry, also known as 'The Pit' to the village football club, on a long lease and in the mid 50's the brick stand was built. In the early 60's following Sir Charlton's passing, his son kindly offered the pit to the football club for a 'very small fee' which was gladly accepted and the place has grown since then.

From what little information is known about the club, we've not had a great deal of success over the years until fairly recently. We played in the Ouse Valley League in the early days and then the Essex and Suffolk Border league before becoming one of the founder members of the Norwich based Anglian Combination League in the early 60's, with our Reserve side playing in the Bury and District League. In the late 90's both sides joined the Cambs League were we have been until 2017-18 and indeed our Reserves side remain and are in Senior B. Most of our success has come in the last 20 years, although our 1st ever County success was in 1970 when we won the under 18's Suffolk Minor Cup. Our 1st Team won the Suffolk Junior Cup in the 70's and our Reserves also won back to back Suffolk Primary Cups in the early 90's.

The last ten years has seen the club establish itself in the upper echelons of Cambridgeshire football winning Senior A in 2008/9 and gaining promotion to Step 7. For the next 9 years we have finished in the top 3 of the Premier Division 6 times, winning the trophy in 2010/11. In 2015 our 1st Team won Suffolk Senior Cup with a record 7-0 score in the final against Ipswich Valley Rangers. I think we are among a handful of clubs that have won each of the County Cups available to us, maybe the only club!

The club appointed Ben Cowling as manager in the Spring of 2018 and he has overseen a dramatic overhaul of the clubs playing staff. On the pitch the clubs first ever season at Step 6 saw them finishing a creditable 5th place. One standout result was a league record away win when the club won 15-0 at Wisbech St Mary's.

2018-19 also saw a significant investment and improvement in the clubs facilities with Flood-lights being installed at the ground for the first time, these were followed by new hard standing and dugouts as the club achieved a 'G' ground grading from the FA.

Season 2019/20 saw the club make history, competing in the FA Vase and fielding an U18 side in the Eastern Counties Floodlit League for the first time. The unfortunate intervention of Covid-19 saw the league campaign end in mid March with the side well within the promotion places. The extended off season allowed for more investment into the ground and facilities with a new tractor and kitchen among the projects completed.
