## What Does It Cost To Join & How To Pay?

### Registration

All players must be registered with the Rugby Football Union (RFU) a copy of the registration form is available from the website. Please ensure it is returned with your membership fee and photos

### What does it cost to join?

Membership fees are as follows:

As last season, the mini section will continue to provide refreshment for TRFC and visiting teams players at home games.

The Juniors have separate arrangements for food subs as they need to pay for visiting teams – it's normally an additional £50 per season (but can vary between age groups) payable to the age group manager.

### Categories of membership

#### Playing

Full Playing Membership: this Membership shall be for the purpose of playing rugby football and carries entitlement for the member to the use of all Club facilities, and for the member to attend and vote at General Meetings of the Club.

#### Family/Club

Family membership is available to children playing in the Min and Junior Sections and one nominated parent or guardian. This membership carries entitlement to the use of all Club facilities, and for the nominated adult to attend and vote at General Meetings of the Club. Children will continue to be covered until they become adults, full playing members or students.

### **Social**

Social Membership: this Membership carries the entitlement to the use of the social facilities of the Club and take part in Social Functions but excludes the use of all playing facilities and excludes the right to vote at any General Meeting of the Club.

### **Please Note**

It is a condition of our continuing tax status as a Community Amateur Sports Club that not less than 50% of our members are 'participating members'. A 'participating member' is defined as players, match officials, coaches, first-aiders/physios and those involved as officers, committee members and in maintaining club facilities

All Members may from time to time invite partners, family members and guests to use the clubhouse facilities.

#### MEMBERSHIP SUBSCRIPTIONS

There are various ways to pay:

Bring your debit card down to the club and complete a card payment – Tuesdays, Thursdays & Sundays

**OR** pay online (bank details below)

**OR** set up a standing order with your bank online (bank details below)

- 1 x Mini Player Family – £9.50 per month (Inc of £12 food subs)
- 2 x Mini Players Family – £15.50 per month (Inc food subs x 2)
- 3 x Mini Players Family – £16.50 per month (Inc food subs x 3)
- 1 x Junior Player Family – £8.50 per month
- 2 or more Junior Players Family – £13.50 per month
- 1 x Club - £8.50 per month
- 1 x Social - £4 per month
