

## RFU UPDATE ON GUIDANCE FOR RESTARTING GRASSROOTS RUGBY (7/8/20)

The RFU has announced the move from **Stage B to Stage C** of the **Return to Rugby Road Map** (and **Ready4Rugby** for U/7s & U/8s) This means that:-

- Training can now involve up to 20 players in 2 teams of 10, using half a pitch, instead of 6 players on a quarter of a pitch.
- The Social Distancing of 2m will not be required at all times when training, but will be before, after and during training intervals. This applies to all coaches, players and spectating parents.
- Equipment sharing should be minimised with only essential equipment shared e.g. balls
- Some Face to Face (F2F) and close contact exposure is now permitted i.e. Touch Rugby, or passive opposition/line of defence.
- But NO tackling, scrummaging, lineouts, rucks or mauls until Stage F is introduced
- Recommend sub sessions of 15 minutes, then clean balls etc with a bucket of soapy water and towel located at each pitch side
- We will provide team coaches with buckets, soap, towels and antiseptic wipes for cleaning balls. Players to provide their own sanitiser.
- Training sessions should not exceed 75 minutes for U/9s and above, and 60 minutes for U/8s and below.
- No one with any symptoms of Covid 19 should attend the Club or any training session
- A register of all players and coaches, plus parent spectators must be taken at each session and given/emailed to Will Brewer for T&T
- The Marquee bar will normally be open after training where the use of hand sanitiser and Social Distancing is required.
- The Age Group Head Coach must send these Guidelines and the Risk Assessment below to all parents and coaches to explain/share with the players before training in Stage C begins. Parents and other coaches should acknowledge both receipt AND ACTION of this email. (i.e. discuss and explain to their children)
